

STELLA'S CAPTAIN CENSURED.

Should have Slowed Down and Stood Out to Sea.

SOUTHAMPTON, April 22.—The Coroner's inquest upon the victims of the disaster of March 30 last, when the passenger steamer Stella of the London & Southwestern Railway Company was wrecked on the Casquet Rocks near the Island of Alderney, during a dense fog and foundered ten minutes later with the loss of over 70 of those on board, has resulted in a verdict of "accidental death," with a rider saying that "if the captain had slowed down and stood out to sea the accident would not have happened."
