

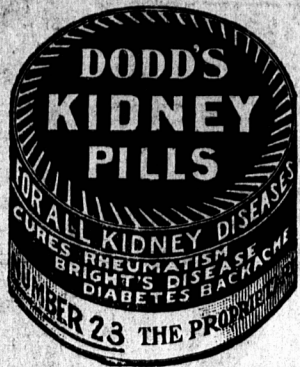

LONDON, July 12.—Canon Hensley Henson of Westminster Abbey declares that the "decision" that hell is a myth, arrived at by the International Bible Students' Association, in session at Washington, is years behind the times.

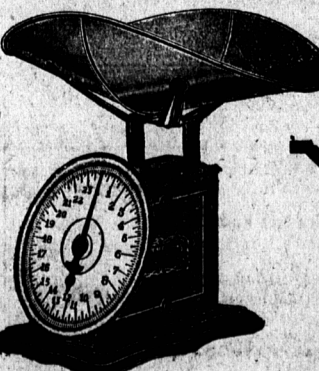

The present indications show that the apple crop on Prince Edward will be short this season. The early apples have set fairly well but the late fall and winter apples are making a very poor showing. This was probably caused by the cold, wet weather that continued during the blossoming season and which interfered with the work of bees and other insects. The prospects in the other Provinces are much the same as here consequently there should be good prices for all apples this fall.

Strawberries made an exceptionally good showing in Prince Edward Island at the beginning of the season, there being a fine appearance of bloom, with the majority of the blossoms setting. However the dry weather, which has been so very prevalent of late, has materially reduced the crop, both in size of berry and number of quarts per acre. Where irrigation is practicable it is very advisable as it would increase the crop considerably. Raspberries, one of the most profitable of the bush fruits, are making a very satisfactory showing at present.

St. Joachim's Church, Vernon River, on Tuesday, the 9th inst., was the scene of a very happy event when Patrick M. Curran of Egmont Bay was united in the holy bonds of matrimony to Miss Minnie A. Hughes of Avondale. The ceremony was performed by Rev. Dr. Morrison, P. P. The bride was beautifully attired in a trailing suit of blue broadcloth with hat to match and was attended by her sister Miss Susie, while the groom was ably supported by his cousin B. W. McNally of Egmont Bay. Immediately after the ceremony the wedding party drove to Millview station and proceeded by train to their future home at Egmont Bay. 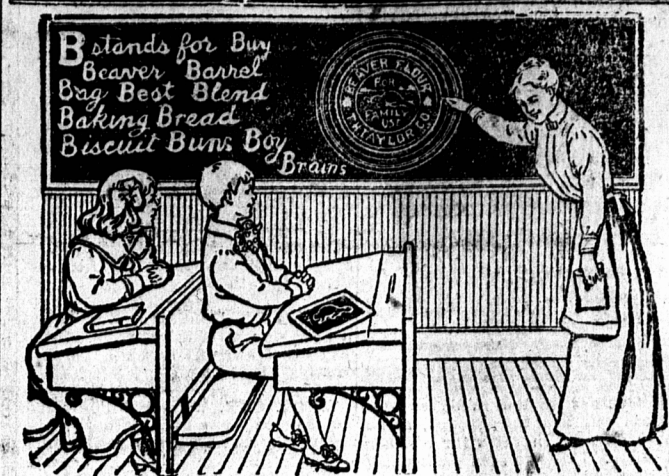

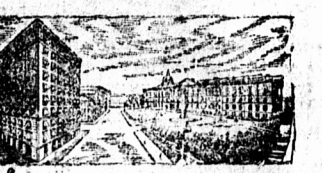

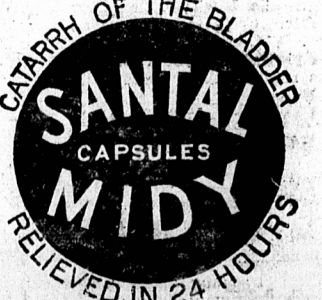
