sugar, 3 apples, peeled and sliced.

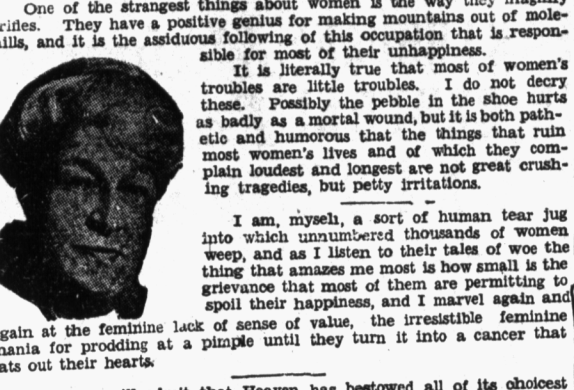
Scalloped Carrots
