VLADIVOSTOK, Oct. 14.—It being six months ago that the battleship Petropavlosk was sunk off Port Arthur, when Admiral Makoff and many others on board perished, memorial services were held in all the churches here yesterday. All the schools will open to-morrow and it is feared there will be considerable increase in the price of food owing to the influx of students and others. There is a comparatively small supply of food in the place, as little was brought in last year either by rail or water, owing to the blockade and to the fact that the military monopolized the use of the railway.

Gedeon Gallant, that experienced sportsman, is meeting with his usual good luck this fall. He shot a crane the other day.

WHEN in town last week Rev. A. E. Burke, President of the Fruit Growers' Association and A. E. Dewar, Secretary accompanied by Richard Burke met the Government with reference to the annual meeting and other important matters connected with fruit growing here. It was decided to hold the meetings in the new Market Hall on Dec 20 and 21st. There will be an immense fruit show in connection with these meetings, every province of Canada sending an exhibit of ten varieties of their best commercial apples and other fruits. The Ottawa Fruit Division will also send a complete exhibit of horticultural tools and implements. There will be speakers of great reputation from abroad and the best talent the province can afford. The night meetings as usual will be interspersed with music and song—Dec 20 and 21 will be days of instruction and entertainment for town and country and it is hoped the citizens will give those patriotic fruit growers the cordial reception they so well deserve. 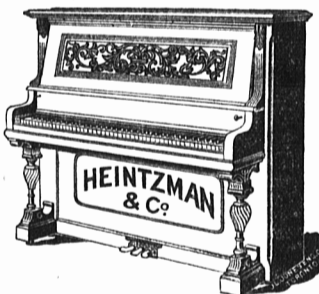
