The summer train schedule on the C. P. R. will go into effect tomorrow June 19. There will be few changes from the present time table. The only difference will be in the time of arrival and departure of the Boston train. Instead of arriving at 11.40 a.m., as at present, it will reach here at 11.10. The departure in the evening will be in five minutes later than at present, namely, 6.45.—St. John Telegraph.

Among the graduates with Miss Barrett in this City and made many friends during her residence here. The presentation of diplomas was made by Rev. G. M. Campbell, D. D. and the address by Rev. Neil McLaughlin, brother of Dr. McLaughlin of this City.

He was joined en route by most of the circulation managers of the Boston dailies and other papers in the eastern section of New England. This year an effort was made to make the association an international one, and every state of the union and province of Canada was represented. Mexico was also in evidence. The aims of this association are far-reaching and by co-operation and good fellowship in the exchange of opinions formed by practical experience many intricate problems confronting the management of newspaper circulation have been solved.—Worcester Telegram. Mr Coulson is a native of Tracadie and is well-known in this province.

Yesterday morning in the Police Court in this city there was a little more than the usual "Monday after" activities. Young Francis Hopkinson, aged twelve years, who, on Saturday afternoon was caught in the act of extracting money from a till in a store in this city, was allowed his liberty with the provision that he procure bonds for his appearance to receive sentence for this offence. The case against Catherine and Bridget McDonald, for keeping a disorderly house, was tried behind closed doors and resulted in the dismissal of the defendants. There were eight witnesses examined in this case. After this the drunk and disorderly men appeared, and three, James Donovan, Leo Mahar and Benj. Byers, were convicted and fined, the former going to jail on an old suspended sentence and the two latter getting ten dollars or thirty days. The three occupants of the wagon, whose fast driving and inconsiderate treatment of their animal created so much comment on the previous day, next appeared. The first sentenced was W. McKay, for being drunk, was fined ten dollars or thirty days. His two companions, who beat and otherwise ill-treated the horse, were fined ten dollars or thirty days for being drunk and cruel treatment to their horse. This sentence was suspended on account of this being their first attendance at court.
