(British United Press.) LONDON, Sept. 16.—A successful fight by doctors to save the life of a baby after his heart had stopped eight times is reported from Balmmain, a suburb of Sydney, Australia. The ten-week-old infant was taken to hospital suffering from bronchial pneumonia. A few hours after admission the breathing stopped and the heart ceased beating. Oxygen was administered, and the heart had to be massaged. On one occasion it stopped beating for a minute and a half. The doctors continued their treatment, and the baby gradually gained strength and is now well on the road.

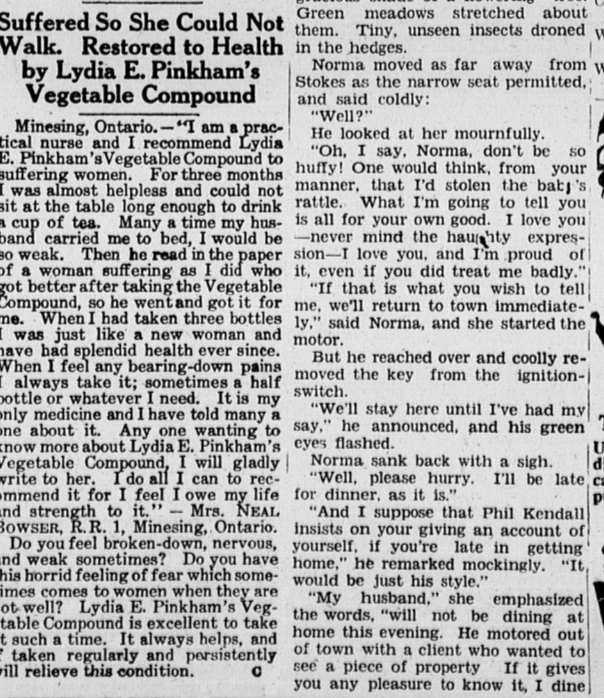

### Economic Loss In Animals Due To Tuberculosis

Tuberculosis in Food Animals is a great economic concern, but is also included in the General Tuberculosis Problem when the infection of human beings from such sources as milk and meat are considered.

When animals are killed in Establishments under Federal Control records are kept of the animals dealt with and losses from Tuberculosis can be closely estimated.

During the 10 year period 1917-1926, the above records show that 55,000 carcasses of cattle, with an estimated value of \$2,035,000 were condemned on account of Tuberculosis. Besides these 450,000 portions of carcasses, with an estimated value of \$450,000 were condemned owing to Tuberculosis.

During this period 40,000 carcasses of hogs, with an estimated value of \$800,000 were also condemned on account of Tuberculosis and 10,000,000 portions of swine carcasses with an estimated value of \$1,116,500 were rejected for the same reason.

Of all carcasses condemned for all causes 47.4 per cent of beef and 71.5 per cent of pork was on account of Tuberculosis.

Tuberculosis is therefore the most serious cause of loss in cattle and swine killed for food purposes in these Establishments.

### An Upstart Deity

MADRAS, Sept. 16.—An upstart "deity" recently provoked a blaze in the peaceful town of Kolkuntla, in South India, which did not die down until seven people had been killed and many wounded by gunfire.

About four years ago a seller of betel leaves named Jayaramiah, who lived in the village of Bijinevumla, about two miles from Kolkuntla, was smitten with leprosy. His customers deserted him, and in desperation he decided to adopt the roll of a Sadhu, a spiritual teacher.

Donning the yellow robe, he opened a mandiram, or place of worship, in the village, set up therein a picture of Sri Rama, one of the gods in the Hindu pantheon, and conducted frequent bhajana (musical) parties.

He was later joined by another trader who had suffered severe losses, and together they accumulated a band of followers drawn mostly from the rogues and vagabonds of Bijinevumla and the surrounding villages.

The police opened fire after two police officers had been wounded by the rioters, with the result, as already stated, that seven of the mob, including Jayaramiah, were killed.

Shortly afterwards, an armed mob headed by Jayaramiah, went to their rescue, and Jayaramiah told his followers that the police bullets would turn to flowers before reaching them.

"The police officers had been ever since the new baby had arrived on the scene. "Say, where did that baby come from anyway?" he asked his mother one day.
