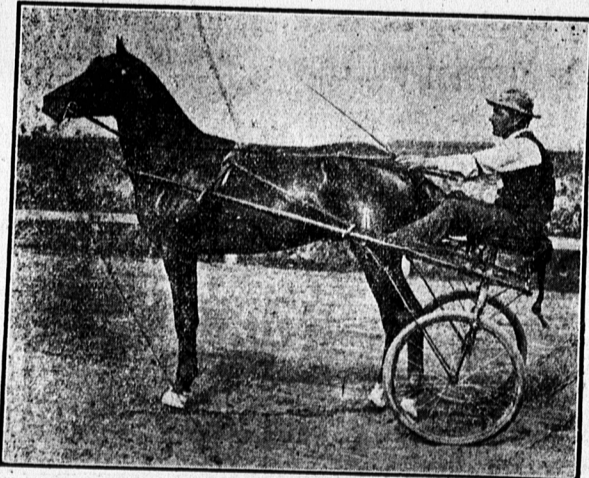

Banito's opportunities in the stud up to the present time have been limited, as he has been in training every season except for a short time in the spring. His oldest foals are 2 year old last season. They are all of good size and the only two that were trained showed miles better than 2:20 on the trot.

The Hissar Emerald. By CLARISSA MACKIE.

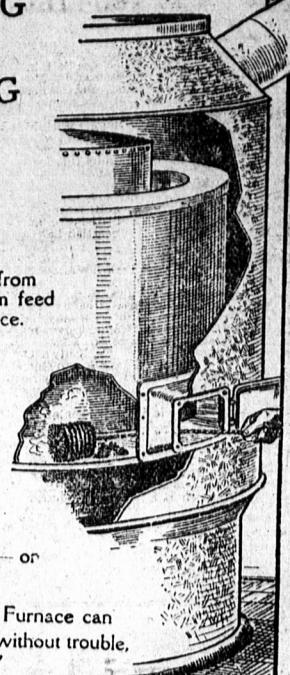

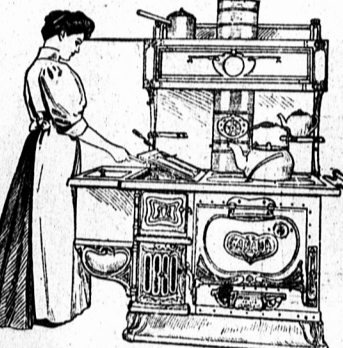

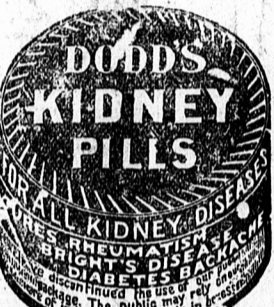
