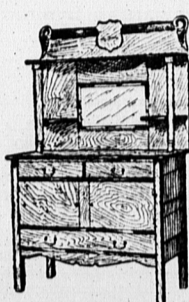

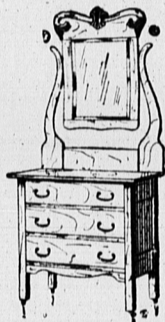

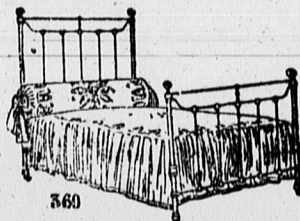

## Trains To Be Held

Provincial Exhibition, Charlottetown, Sept 27th to Oct. 1st. INCLUSIVE

Trains Nos 10, which usually leaves for Murray Harbor at 3.59 p.m. and No. 2 train which leaves on Saturday only at 4.00 p.m. will be held Tuesday to Saturday, Sept. 27th to Oct. 1st. Inclusive until 6.10 p.m.
