You are entirely wrong in thinking that spinster is a term of reproach when applied to a woman. It simply indicates that she is unmarried.

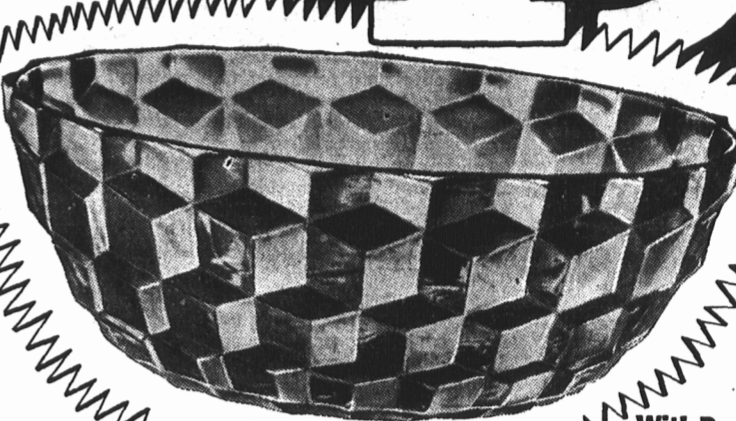
CROSS STITCH PENGUIN MOTIF
