ISLAND MEN WHO ARE IN ARCOLA

Succeeding in the Prairies of the West.

An Interesting Letter Descriptive of the Town of Arcola From the Pen of Morley Seller, of Hunter River.

Many friends in the city and country will be pleased to learn of the success of Morley Seller of Hunter River and Lemuel J. McLeod now located in Arcola, Assa, and are both doing excellently.

Mr. Seller writing to a friend in the city says:

When you look at the town I am in I feel sure you will not be able to locate it exactly as it is one of those mushroom villages that have sprung into existence during the past two years or so. Like a mushroom only in the rapidity of its growth into maturity for this village, now seeking incorporation into a town with well defined boundaries, is certainly destined to be a prairie town of future note. Structures of permanence, of stability, are wending their way with brick and stone into the air to become the habitation of finance, of religious and secular instruction as well as the transforming process of wheat to flour. The Union Bank of Canada will be the first completed and occupied and certainly it would attain to prominence in a much larger place of greater pretensions. We may at present present a rough and uncouth appearance to the scolded easterner but we really enjoy the novelty and easily adapt our ways to the ideas of the Westerner.

In the second place it is a pleasure to worthy citizens and a gratification to the P. Esbyterian himself to learn that holy purposes during the present summer to erect an edifice at the estimated cost of between \$5000 and \$6000 and to have the same dedicated to the worship of God before the snows of winter appear. They have among their number 17 members who have volunteered \$100 each for payment this fall and that one fact shows that although there is yet uncertainty to the present crop these farmers and others have plenty ready to live and meet such an obligation. And now we come to the care of the children in a secular way. Permit has been granted this town to go ahead with a new 4 department school at approximate value of \$8,200 and as we all agree that the future depends on the young and rising generation we have ample evidence of the quantity when it is expected the four departments will be occupied before long; as for the quality our hope is built on the sample of instructors selected to guide and instruct. And as for our bread future we have assurance sufficient that, if the country yields its natural growth of wheat, the 100 barrel mill supposed to be in operation this fall will grind out all the flour necessary to sustain. In addition to those public structures there are in the vicinity of 20 dwelling houses to be erected for the already married, those who hope is stationed in the near future. Wages are good, boarding accommodation is either not to be had or almost beyond the poorly filled purse, and the cost of lumber is extremely exorbitant—a combine existing.

I ought to mention among other things the project on foot to establish a brickyard near the city (or rather village yet) it was reported in our weekly one-sheet newspaper, five acres of land had been secured which contains a large quantity of excellent brick clay. New I have pictured the optimistic side, but the other view can only be occasioned by these things over which we have no control, viz. poor crops and low prices, and those things we leave in the hands of all wise Providence, who doeth all things well. J. L. McLeod, who came out with me, is conducting a fruit, confectionery and ice cream parlor which is very

profitable. There is another pathway that is already well-trodden by the get-rich-quick individual of the past and of the future and that is the pathway of land speculation. From three to five years ago land of A1 quality could be purchased from the C. P. R. on easy payment terms for \$3 to \$4 per acre, while today that same land is held as high as \$10 and \$12 to \$15. The very poorest is classed at \$6 per acre. A lot of the land has been homesteaded during the past five years and fortunate surely would the person be who can today find a quarter section worth filling the duties required by law which are six months residence in each year for three years before a patent or deed will be granted the applicant. About a fortnight ago I had a drive 25 miles S. W. of Arcola and located two-quarter sections (a section = 160 acre) tangent to each other. Mr. McLeod has a young man by name Gillis from the Province by the Sea with him this week. Last winter he went to the Oxenham C. C. and only came west this spring.

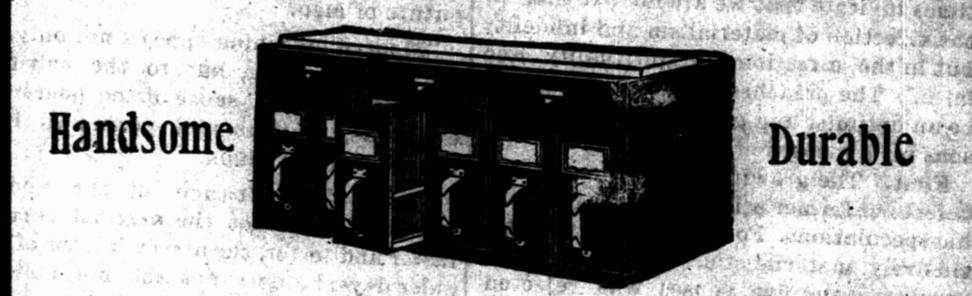
