IN MEMORIAM
JOHN W. LANK

At the Prince Edward Island Hospital, on Saturday evening, August 16th, there passed to his great reward, after a brief illness John W. Lank, Superintendent of Schools of Ramseur, North Carolina U. S. A. The late Mr. Lank was born on Campobello Island, New Brunswick, thirty-one years ago, only son of Mr. Beverly Lank and his wife who still reside there. After receiving his early education in the public schools of New Brunswick, he proceeded to Acadia University, from which he graduated in 1922. He next spent two years at Newton Theological Seminary, and the summers in Christian work, expecting to offer for the Christian Ministry, but failing health guided him into the teaching profession in which he has since been engaged. In 1924 Mr. Lank married Laura Bagnall, daughter of the late Joseph Bagnall, of Hazelgrove, P. E. I., a classmate at Acadia. His brief but trying illness was borne with Christian fortitude, and those who loved him rejoice in the call which has taken him out of suffering to be "with Christ which is far better."

The burial will take place in Campobello on Wednesday, Mr. Andrew Bagnall, Mrs. Lank's brother, is accompanying the bereaved parents on their return to N. B.
