SIR THOMAS GIVES HIS VIEWS. LONDON, Dec 15—Sir Thomas Shaughnessy gave his views here today on the Navy question. "Personally I should like to see Canada ask Great Britain to draw up a plan and build two Dreadnoughts at Canada's expense, then we should lend them to Great Britain on a nine-year lease for a dollar a year." He had nothing to say about building new liners for the Atlantic service. "We are willing to do our part the remainder depends on the Government. Twenty-one knot steamers could make the passage in the same time as Cunard boats, twenty-one knot service could equal the Lusitania and twenty-one knot boats could beat her. With the assistance of the two Governments I hope to see the boats—but there are no definite plans yet. "The idea of starting boats from Blacksod Bay is not practical. It would cost as much to carry emigrants from Liverpool to Blacksod as we now receive for the whole journey."
