### THE C.P.R. AND THE FAST LINE

There is a rumor in the air that since the probable failure of the Petersen contract the Canadian Pacific Railway Company will make proposals for undertaking the Fast Atlantic service between Canada and the Mother Country. This great railway corporation has undoubtedly an interest only second to that of Canada itself in having an excellent steamship service on the Atlantic. Its trans-continental railway, Pacific and Australian steamship lines and admirable telegraph service give this great corporation a grasp on the travel and traffic of the northern hemisphere which is not surpassed if it is equalled by any other.

There can be little doubt, from what the C. P. R. has already accomplished that if that corporation should undertake to give a steamship service for passengers, mails and freight on the Atlantic they would give a magnificent service. To some minds there may be a sense of danger in entrusting so much to a single corporation, but on the other hand the country would be advantaged by having unity of control in bringing over Canadian highways the vast and increasing volume of round-the-world travel. Our geographical situation favors a great development in both trans-Atlantic and trans-continental traffic through our own ports and over our own railways, and the C. P. R. has done more to that end than any other Canadian agency.

There may be nothing, or there may be much in the rumor, but the Canadian public is becoming not a little impatient to have our Atlantic mail and passenger service greatly improved, and there is a general feeling that to attain that end the work must be entrusted to a company possessing both energy and resources commensurate with a great undertaking.

### A FRIENDLY NOTICE

The Buffalo Express pays a tribute to Canadian progress, the freedom of our citizenship and the excellence of our governmental institutions in which among other things, it says:—

From the very beginning the young Dominion evinced a disposition to govern itself without British interference and Great Britain wisely, and with prophetic judgement, gave it free rein. The result has been to bind the young nation closely to the mother country and to develop a self-reliant government which has shown itself capable of negotiating treaties, disposing of inter-necine, racial and religious difficulties; of opening up to commerce and immigration millions of acres of hitherto inaccessible, but extremely valuable, agricultural lands, of constructing a national highway across the continent, and, in short, of becoming the most-prized colonial gem in the British diadem.

Her untrammelled system of government leads the Dominion to feel the responsibilities of independent national existence, and no sentiment could better express the precise state of things today than these lines in a recent poem: "Daughter, am I in my mother's house, But Mistress am I in my own." Canada is prosperous and happy. The recent bank statements and crop reports, as well as the reports from the gold mines in British Columbia and Northwestern Ontario exclusive entirely of the vast treasures of the Canadian Yukon district, argue that the present year is full of promise.

The sagacious in trade is giving way to an improved business situation, and the establishment of increased trade facilities between Canada and this country by the proposed Quebec conference should accelerate the "good times coming." Canadian sympathy with the United States in our difficulty

with Spain has been unreserved and dignified, and the improved relations between the two neighbors may also be classed with the substantial evidence of Canadian progress in the path of national greatness.

There is much truth in this statement of the Toronto World: "We talk of a fast Atlantic line, but is it not a fast St Lawrence line that we have been aiming at? It is a question whether it is advisable to take the fast Atlantic steamships up to Quebec or Montreal at all. Half the difficulty of raising capital for a fast mail line is due to the fact that we have been trying to establish a fast St Lawrence service instead of a fast Atlantic service. Possibly it would pay to make it an Atlantic service in name as well as name." By the attempt to create a fast St Lawrence service Canada loses the whole of her geographical advantage of being much nearer to Europe on the east than any part of the United States. The fast Atlantic service should find its western terminal at some Canadian port on the eastern coast of Canada. The World proposes St John as the terminal port for both summer and winter, with Louisburg as a possible port of call on the way.
