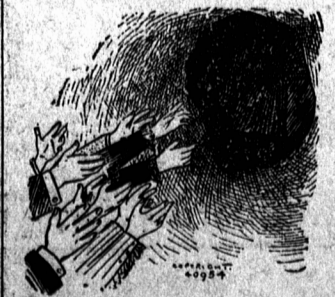

THE STEAMERS.—The Earl Grey from Pictou arrived in port at 10.45 a. m. with 65 tons weight, 130 sacks of mail and 30 passengers. The Minto from Charlottetown to Pictou arrived at that port at 12.45 p. m. She took over from the Island 108 tons freight, 50 sacks mail and 18 passengers. Both steamers will make the return trip today.

EVANGELISTIC SERVICES.—The annual special evangelistic services of the Baptist Church will begin tonight. Rev. W. L. Fash will conduct the series of meetings, which will last two or three weeks. Services will be held each night except Saturday, beginning at eight o'clock. All are free to come and will be made welcome. Miss Dianch Boyver will have charge of the music.

THE DIVERS.—It is not often that the interesting spectacle—divers at their work—is seen about the wharves of Charlottetown; but on Good Friday, in the morning and the afternoon two divers were seen actively engaged in diving near the marine wharf, endeavoring to reclaim some freight which had been lost through an accident, while the Minto was being discharged at this port last Wednesday. The gang-plank, on which the cargo is taken from the steamer to the wharf slipped and about ten barrels of pork and several cases of condensed milk fell overboard and went to the bottom. The divers were brought here from Pictou by the Labor Union. On Friday they were successful in recovering three barrels of pork. Yesterday they worked for an hour and a half and brought up one of condensed milk.
