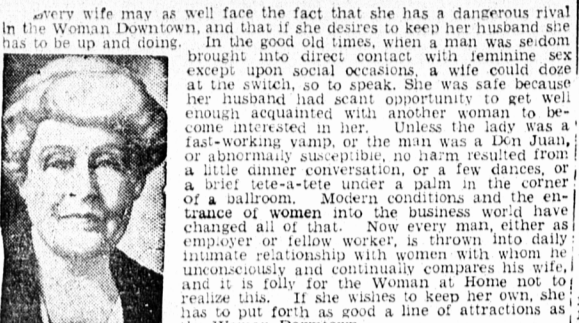

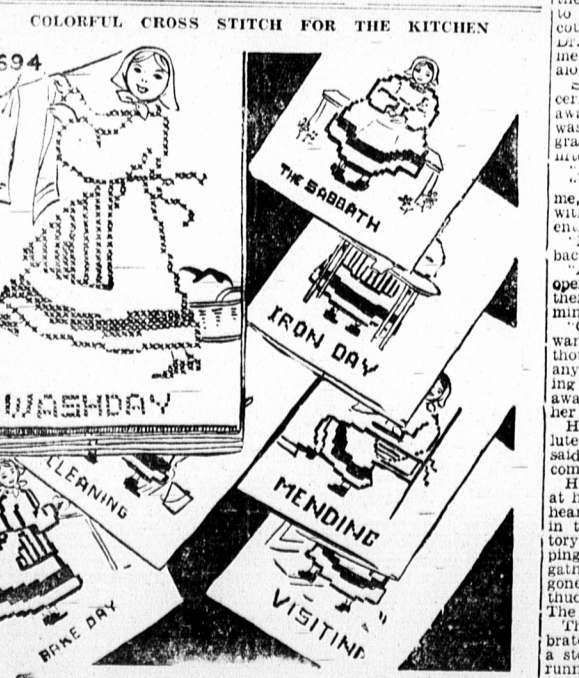
In innumerable households about all the conversation that the wife hands out is a monologue on her husband's shortcomings.

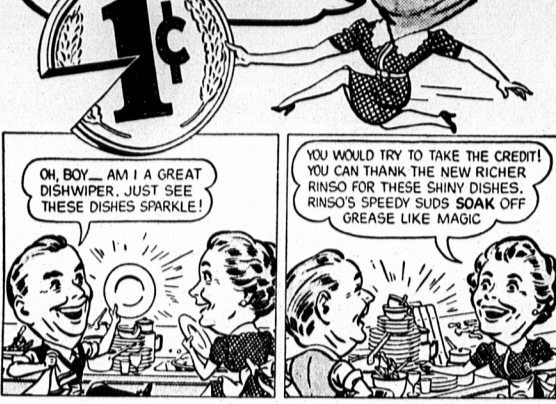

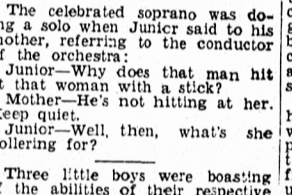
