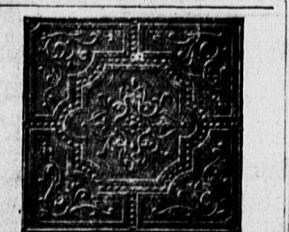

**Sounds Good For Radio Enthusiasts**

LONDON, October 26.—A curious result of wireless tests between Great Britain and Argentina on a short wave length was disclosed by William Marconi, speaking at Central Hall, Westminster, last night. He said that his engineer, Captain Pound, was using a 15 metre wave length and one-fifth of a kilowatt at the transmitting end, which is about the average length used by amateurs in their experiments and had found it not only possible but easy to communicate from Chelmsford, about 25 miles northeast of London, with Argentina during the daylight hours, while experiments were unsuccessful in other countries. "I found out, enthusiasts would not have stayed up all night to communicate with friends in other countries," Sir Oliver Lodge paying tribute to Marconi, complimented him on his new discovery that a long wave preferred the darkness while a short wave preferred light.

**Unusual Season**

TORONTO, Oct. 26.—The unsettled condition of the weather which has prevailed practically since September 21, will continue for some time, said Sir Frederick Stupart, chief of the weather bureau here today.

"We have had a most unusual season of autumn cold, I think it is many years since the mean temperatures have been as low as they have since September 20."

—FIRE YESTERDAY.—The fire alarm sounded in Summerside yesterday afternoon shortly before 3 o'clock for a fire in the residence of Mr. Harry Arsenault at the east end of the town. The firemen were promptly on the scene and soon put the blaze under control. Considerable damage was done by water.

—CAR DEMOLISHES TELEPHONE POLE.—Yesterday morning one of the electric light poles in front of Mr. G. R. McQuarrie's office, Summerside broke in two as a result of being hit by an automobile. The car was parked in front of Harding's garage in reverse gear and as soon as the motor was started backed down and snapped off the post about half way up. The car was considerably damaged.

—POPULAR CAPTAIN.—Captain Alfred McLeod, French River, weighed anchor Thursday morning in New London Harbor, took bearings for the high seas, shaping his course for Charlottetown. His ship is identified by the name Eliza Graham, is a staunch, sea-worthy vessel and cannot be lee-bound by any boating vessel of equal capacity. With weather propitious he expects to be moored again at French River in time to add one more vote to the candidate that he will support in election. Let his opponents in politics not invoke inclement weather. Capt. McLeod navigates a cargo of potatoes, a consignment from the French River Potato Growers Association, and this is a sufficient guarantee that the stock is as good as any produced in the Province, and the cargo is under safe command as competent seamanship can secure.—Y.

—THE STORM.—The storm and high wind of Sunday night and the gale of yesterday did considerable damage in Summerside and Prince County. Some of the main telephone lines were down and many of the local ones out of order. The schooner Pacific, owned by Mr. Sampson Grady, Summerside, which left at 7 o'clock Sunday morning with a cargo of coal for Holman's, dropped anchor outside the breakwater Sunday night about 9 p.m. Her two anchor chains broke and she drifted on the bar at the mouth of Summerside harbor. She sprung a leak and was driven further up on the bar. Capt. Hardy and crew of four men stayed on until yesterday afternoon and when they saw nothing could be done to save her abandoned the craft. Last night the schooner was still on the shoals with tons of spray dashing high over her. An attempt was made to assist her yesterday morning when four men endeavored to reach her in a motor boat. The motor boat went aground on the bar and was unable to render any assistance. If the gale abates there may be some chance of saving the schooner and her cargo before she is too badly damaged to float. There was no insurance on either the schooner or cargo. About a week ago this same vessel with a cargo of coal drifted on the same bar but was floated with slight damage.

**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

We understand that at some of the late political meetings reference was made to a pamphlet bearing our firm's name from which interested parties inferred that this firm was advocating Conservative principles.

We may say that while the members of our firm and staff have always been at perfect liberty to take—as they have done—definite political views, our firm as a firm has never entered, nor does it intend to enter into a political campaign. We, however, as individuals feel that in this instance we are forced to definitely explain the circumstances so as to clear up any misunderstanding.

A certain manufacturer of clothing in Montreal, whose line we had been handling for many years, put up the following proposition to us: They would mail a limited number of booklets showing attractive styles of clothing, if we would furnish a list and pay the postage. We agreed and the booklets were mailed.

They decided to send out later a leaflet entitled "Commercial Creed for Canadians". These leaflets were mailed by them direct from Montreal at their own expense and they themselves paying the postage.

The very moment that samples of these leaflets were received by us we saw their true meaning and the apparent reason why they had been mailed out just before the election and we immediately wired, on October 22nd, the morning that they were received: "Is Commercial Creed leaflet mailed? Wish withheld. Wire reply. Writing." The prompt answer read: "Leaflet mailed last Friday. Balance forwarded to you following day."

It was then clear that the manufacturer had apparently deliberately mailed the leaflet on which they had printed our name and address, first to our customers before they mailed them to us, thus preventing us from any action in the matter and giving the impression that we had mailed them; while in truth they had been mailed direct from Montreal by the manufacturer and at the manufacturer's expense.

The leaflet printed and distributed by them is entitled: "Commercial Creed for Canadians" and advocates a patriotic claim that Canadians trade at home claiming that sending the dollar to different lands causes the children to follow—chasing after it—and that when they are away your home is desolate and your property is worthless etc.

The original intention of the manufacturer was to slip the leaflet containing their propaganda and advice, in with the style booklet. They explain the reason for sending it separately was that they themselves had the style booklet printed in the United States, because they could there procure it cheaper and therefore their urging at the same time the importance of promoting home industry might be understood by the people.

We believe that the above statement of reference to the circulation of the leaflets—and the style booklets printed in the United States—clearly shows who is responsible for the distribution of the leaflets; and that the manufacturer does not himself put into practice his patriotic commercial creed that he has printed and which he advocates for his customers.

We wish to take this opportunity of definitely stating that the undersigned stand firm and strong in the ranks of Liberalism, believing its principles and policies to be in the best interests of Prince Edward Island, the Maritime Provinces and Canada. We believe also that higher protection from our experience and from present negotiations with the Canadian manufacturer means higher prices for the merchandise we buy, and is not in the best interests of this Province.
