If the old strawberry beds are so full of weeds that they cannot be pulled out cut them down, as it will do no harm to mow the strawberries with the weeds. In the winter the rows may be covered with straw, leaves or dried weeds, which will not injure the strawberry plants, and leave the rows clean as well as destroying weed seeds that may be on the surface of the ground.

The best way to preserve eggs is to use no solutions or packing material, but place them on racks or in open slatted boxes, and turn them half over three times a week, keeping them in a cool place, and using eggs only from hens not with eggs.
