MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - Weakness persisted Tuesday on the Montreal Stock Exchange. Volume was light and brokerage sources said there appeared to be an attitude of watching for a selling climax in New York.

The market largely followed New York except for independent reports of Canadian companies.

International Nickel suffered the heaviest reverse, losing 2 1/2 points at 93 - low for the year - on 3,000 shares. Bell Telephone, likewise affected by poorer earnings than anticipated, lost 1/2 at 50 1/4.

Better earnings sent B.C. Forest up 1 1/2 points in the afternoon on 310 shares, with the close at 22 1/2. Steel of Canada, on about 4,100 shares, moved up near the close to finish 1/2 higher at 23.

ALCAN UP 1/4 - Alcan finished up 1/4. Distillers-Seagram rallied to close at 30 1/4, off 1/4.

Senior oils were lower. Home A, was up 1/2 at 20 1/4 after touching 19 1/2. Imperial gained 1/2 but, in light volume, Shell, with the close at 22 1/2.

CPR finished with a gain of 1/4 at 59 1/4 and Massey-Ferguson up 1/4 at 34. Canada Cement and Du Pont lost 1/2 and Moore Corp was down a point.

Brinco finished unchanged at 5 1/4 and 39 1/2. The index for papers was up. Bathurst gained 1/2 at 29 1/4 and MacMillan-Bloedel at 26.

Abitibi lost 1/2 at 10 1/4. The Montreal exchange recorded 53 declines and 27 advances, with 60 stocks unchanged.

In index, industrials were off 0.79 at 156.61; utilities off 0.20 at 137.30; banks off 0.27 at 115.35, and papers up 0.71 at 114.89. The composite index was at a low of 149.09, off 0.63.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) - Key industrial issues were hit by selling Tuesday on the Toronto Stock Exchange following a flood of reports of lower net earnings by a number of large Canadian companies.

The industrial index, a measure of key stock movements, slid 1.31 to 156.80. At mid-afternoon the index dropped to 156.71, its lowest level since July, 1965.

A sharp slump Monday on the New York Exchange, which broke 1965, industrial 10 w.s. added weight to the Toronto decline.

A number of Bay Street analysts said the New York market's slide to below what was believed a floor level shattered investor confidence.

INCO HITS NEW LOW - Inco passed the Toronto decline, tumbling 3 1/4 to 196 1/2, following reports that earnings in the first six months were \$73,630,000 against \$75,846,000 for the same period last year.

Bell Telephone declined 1/2 to 50 1/2 on 10,010 shares. General Motors was off 1/4 to 86 1/4, B.C. Sugar 1 to 36, Dominion Textile 1/4 to 196 1/2 of 28 and CPR 1/2 to 59 1/2.

Banff and Seary Railway fell 1/2 each to 12 1/2 and 13 1/2 in western oils had Home A 1/4 to 30 1/4.

United Kenn highlighted mining issues, jumping 1 1/2 to 44 on 44,505 shares. One brokerage house said they know of no reason for the sudden increase in the stock. The company, a silver producer, is drilling in the Yukon.

On index, golds were down 100 to 186.03, base metals 33 to 97.37, western oils 34 to 102.80 and the TSE 1.21 to 149.84. Volume was 2,264,000 shares compared with 1,989,000 Friday.
