The Business Society hockey team soundly defeated the Vets

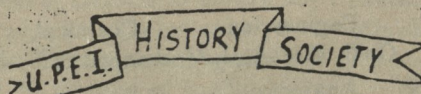
and the Alumni. It is highly unlikely that the Business Society team will be defeated this year because of their highly successful opening.
