Orangemen Hold Parade In Ireland

BELFAST (AP) — While Roman Catholics remained indoors, 100,000 Protestant Orangemen marched through this tense capital of Northern Ireland Tuesday, celebrating the 17th century Battle of Boyne that assured a Protestant monarchy.

As they marched, Prime Minister Terence O'Neill called for an end to religious strife.

Speaking from an Orange Day rally at Cullybackey, 25 miles from Belfast, O'Neill warned that if there is one way to endanger the constitution of Northern Ireland, it is by violence and the gun.

Earlier, 60,000 members of the Loyal Orange Order cheered unanimous approval of resolutions from their grand lodge condemning recent moves towards collaboration with Roman Catholics and demanding a return to the principles of the Protestant reformation.

O'Neill is a member of the order.

LINKED WITH BRITAIN

Northern Ireland, a territory carved from the northeastern corner of this partitioned island, is linked with Britain in the United Kingdom.

The Irish Republic, its larger Catholic neighbor, is independent. Northern Ireland's population is composed of 1,000,000 Protestants and 500,000 Roman Catholics. They live together in uneasy-tension.

In the last few weeks, three Catholics have been murdered, schools have been set on fire by gasoline bombs, and a rock was thrown at the royal car during the Queen's visit.

This year's Orange Day celebrates a Protestant victory nearly 300 years ago. The battle was the one in 1690 that saw William of Orange defeat Catholic King James II.

Rev. Ian Paisley, a Protestant extremist leader who heads his own Free Presbyterian Church, is challenging the government's efforts to improve relations with Dublin.

Paisley calls O'Neill a traitor and says the ecumenical movement toward a united church only means a takeover by Rome. Many Protestant Ulster men agree with him.

His campaign could cause a split between extremists and moderates within the Orange order itself, which has controlled Northern Ireland politically, socially and religiously since partition in 1922.

Finance Minister Herbert Kinn, an Orangeman like all others in the Ulster cabinet, was shouted down when he proposed a resolution of confidence in O'Neill at the Belfast Orange meeting.

Cavalcade Completes Journey

PORT AUX BASQUES, Nfld. (CP) — A two-mile cavalcade officially opening Newfoundland's \$65-million Trans-Canada Highway reached the end of its journey Wednesday.

Premier Smallwood led the cavalcade into this west-coast port, riding the Landrover in which he travelled the Trans-Canada in 1958. It was the first motor vehicle to cross the island.

He opened a new stadium, made a speech, and then set off for St. John's where the cavalcade started three days ago and where he is meeting today with some American businessmen.

The businessmen are to pick him up at Stephenville, Nfld. in their jet.

PLAN CIVIL DEFENCE

HAVANA (Reuters) — Cuba has established a national council of civil defence to co-ordinate all political and mass activities in case of war. Presided over by President Osvaldo Dorticos, the council also will operate during natural crises such as hurricanes.

FIGHT INJUNCTIONS

KITCHENER (CP) — The Canadian Labor Congress has called a meeting for Sept. 27 and 28 to "correlate" its fight across Canada against the use of court injunctions in labor disputes. Morden Lazarus, public relations director of the Ontario Federation of Labor, said Tuesday. The Kitchener-Waterloo and District Labor Council voted to seek support from all union men in the area in an OFL appeal for \$100,000 to fight injunctions.

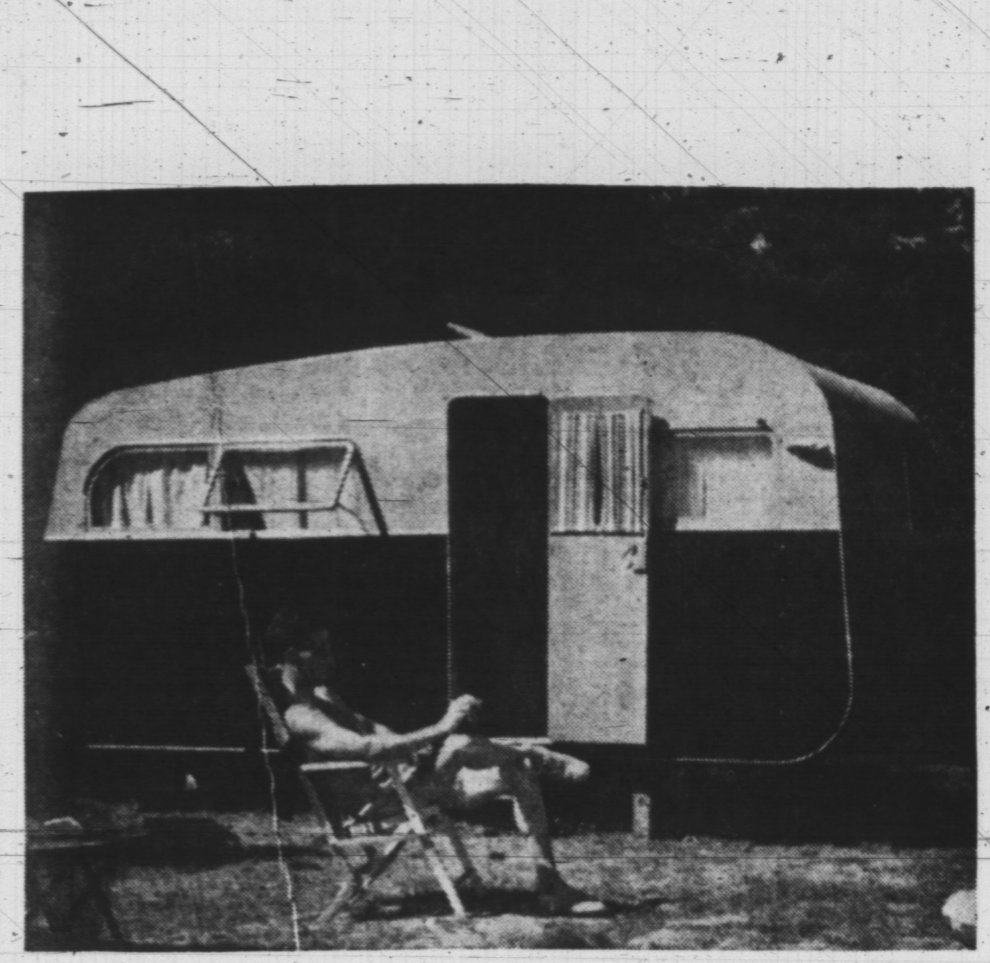
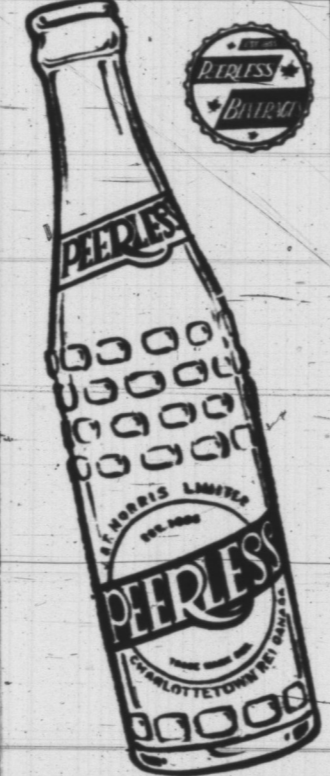
