I would like to take this opportunity to thank the people who helped me with Fall Fest.

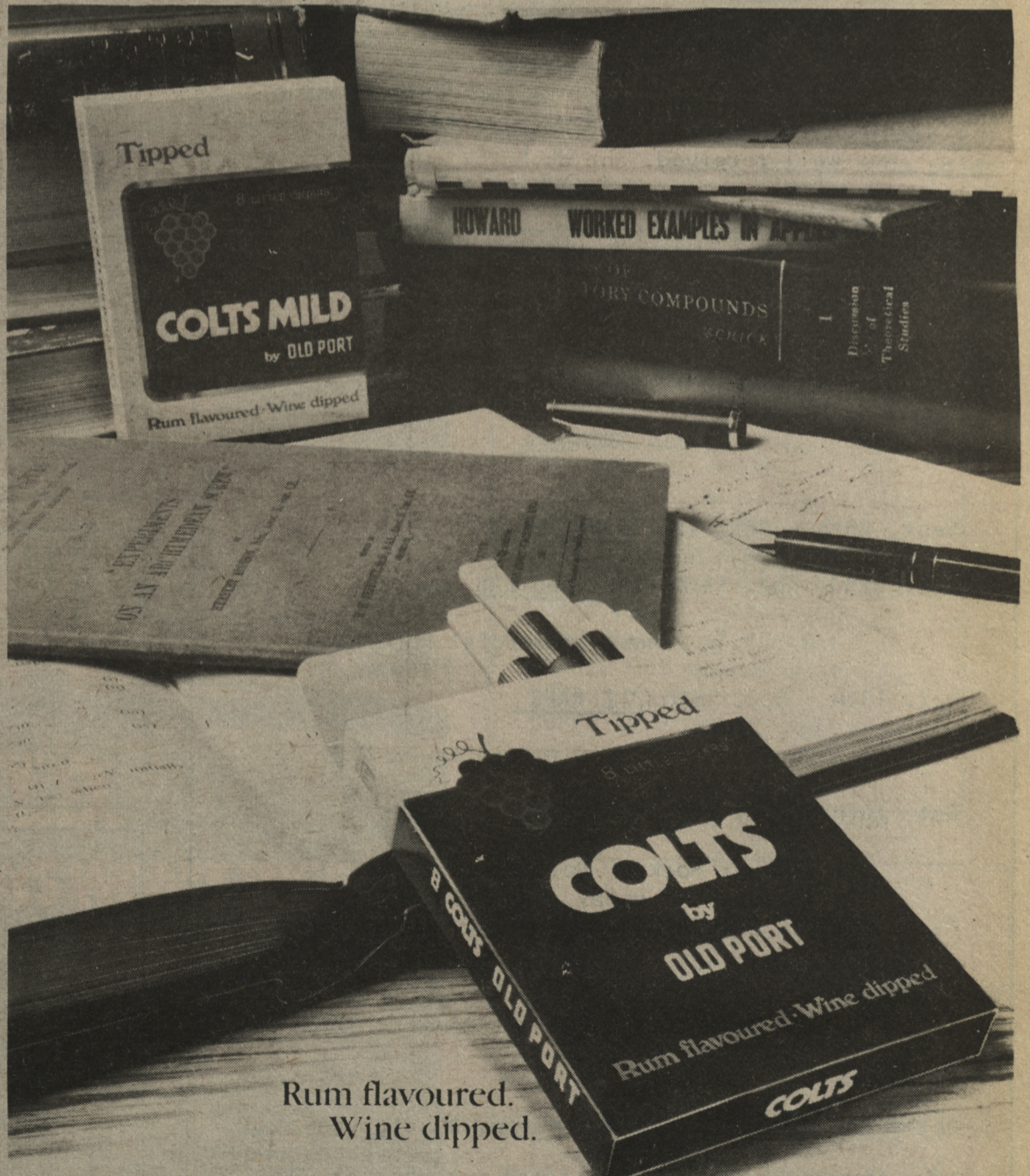
