

scrape) and 5 adults on Jun. 8 with nest 1 being lost and a new nest with 1 egg, nest 2 having 3 eggs, and nest 3 gone with recent flood tide of June 7th creating havoc (JW), 1 at Souris Causeway south beach on Jun. 19 (EMa), 8 adults at West St. Peter's (Redhead Harbour) on Jul. 24 and 3 immature on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Killdeer** - 4 eggs in nest on May 4 at Village Green field (JH), 1 at West Royalty on May 9 (DO), 11 at Nine Mile Creek on Jul. 14 (EMa), 6 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Greater Yellowlegs** - 1 at Fortune Bay on Apr. 19 (EMa), 1 at Brackley Beach on May 1 (EMa), 10 at Rice Point on Jul. 31 (EMa), 12 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 and 45 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Lesser Yellowlegs** - 25 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 and 60 on Aug. 7 (EVL), 20 at Rice Point on Jul. 31 (EMa); **Solitary Sandpiper** - 1 at Pisquid Pond on Jul. 28 (EMa & JMa), 1 at Mermaid Lake on Aug. 10 (SB, FRC); **Willet** - 1 at Brackley Beach on May 1 (EMa), 1 at Redhead on May 22 (EMa), 3 pair at Dog Island Sand Hills on Jun. 27 (FRC), 5 at Rice Point on Jul. 31 (EMa); **Spotted Sandpiper** - 12 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Whimbrel** - 2 at Redhead Harbour sand flats on Aug. 4 and 7 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Hudsonian Godwit** - 1 at Covehead Harbour on Apr. 7 (JJ), 4 at Covehead on Jul. 18, and 1 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Ruddy Turnstones** - 1 at Rice Point on Jul. 20 (EMa), 50 on Jul. 28 at Rice Point (EMa & JMa) & 10 on Jul. 31 (EMa), 2 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 and 8 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Red Knots** - 3 at Rice Point on Jul. 28 (EMa, JMa); **Sanderling** - 150 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 & 400 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Semi-palmated Sandpiper** - 4 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24, 600 on Aug. 4, 2000 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Least Sandpiper** - 1 on Jul. 14 at Nine Mile Creek (EMa), 15 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 & 50 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **White-rumped Sandpiper** - 22 at sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 31, 18 on Aug. 4, 340 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Pectoral Sandpiper** - 2 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Purple Sandpiper** - 1 at Souris on May 2 (EMa); **Dunlin** - at P.E.I. National park on May 1 (LT), 1 at Redhead on May 22 (EMa); **Short-billed Dowitcher** - 40 at Rice Point on Jul. 20 (EMa), 300 at Covehead on Jul. 18 & 8 on sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Common Snipe** - winnowing at Green Bay on Apr. 2 (JW), at Fullerton's Marsh on Apr. 3 (DO), at Tryon on Apr. 24 (DO); **American Woodcock** - singing at Riverton on Mar. 28 (TR), 1 at Indian Bridge on May 8 (DO), singing at French Village on May 19 to 26 but no peenting heard (HG), 1 at De Gros Marsh on May 22 (EMa), each year at our place (Morell RR 1) they occupy an alder thicket and make themselves know by their whistling flight (JMu); **Wilson's Phalarope** - 1 at Covehead on May 21 (JJ) and May 26 (EMa); **Red-necked Phalarope** - 3 attracted by chum of sand lances, cod frames & livers, mackerel, & herring on Aug. 12 3.78 miles off North Lake (EVL); **Laughing Gull** - 2 bill clacking at Souris causeway on Jun. 19 (EMa), 2 juveniles, 1 bird with an injured leg on Jul. 31 at entrance bar to St Peter's Bay (EVL); **Bonaparte's Gull** - at P.E.I. National Park on May 1 (LT), 81 sub-adults at Pownal Bay Islands on Jun. 27 (FRC), 45 at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 (EVL); **Lesser Black-backed Gull** - 1 almost fully adult ½ mile west of Basin Head on Aug. 1st, 2 second summer birds at entrance to St. Peter's Bay on Aug. 2, 2nd summer bird at North Lake Harbour on Aug. 6, 1 ratty looking, heavy molt, 3rd summer going to 4th with just a little black on outer retrices & molting mantle, scapulars, & wing feathers on Aug. 11, 1 first summer bird, 2 second year types and a third year adult with several thousand gulls feeding on offal and fish parts from North Lake Fish Co-op on Aug. 11 (EVL), not less than 1 per day between 11th and 17th at North Lake Harbour and 10 [2 first summer, 4 second summer, and 4 3rd summer birds] were observed at North Lake Harbour under idea conditions on the 17th (EVL); **Black-legged Kittiwake** - 1 adult & 3 immature attracted by chum of sand lances, cod frames & livers, mackerel, & herring on Aug. 12 3.78 miles off North Lake (EVL); **Sabine's Gull** - 1 immature at Rice Point sandspit on Aug. 11 (EMa); **Caspian Tern** - 2 at Covehead on May 10 (EMa), 1 at Redhead on May 22 (EMa), 2 at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24, 3 with a recently fledged begging juvenile at entrance bar to St. Peter's Bay, 3 including 1 fledgling on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Common Tern** - 3 back at Hillsborough Bridge piers on May 4 (JDM), 60 adults with a couple of pairs displaying courtship to no avail at sand flats at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 (EVL), 75 with 12 fledglings at entrance bar to St. Peter's Bay on Jul. 31 & 65 on Aug. 7 (EVL); **Arctic Tern** - 3+ at Covehead Harbour on Jun. 19 (BF), 2 adults and 1 first year "Portladica" type at Redhead Harbour on Jul. 24 (EVL), 1 lone 2 year old at entrance bar to St. Peter's Bay on Jul. 31 (EVL); **Razorbill** - 1 found dead at Kildare on Jun. 9 (PMaCl, WL), 1 in the company of a Black Guillemot, flew from the cliff at Cape Tryon on Jun. 13 (BF); **Black Guillemot** - 5 in East Point area on Apr. 7 (EMa), 21 were seen exploring the cliff at Guernsey Cove for nests on Apr. 28 (EMa), many seen in National Park on May 7th (BMCo & RA), 6 at Cape Bear on May 25 (JDM, RC), 8 at North Cape tending nests on May 27 (JDM, RC, LT, RP, EMa), 17 at North Cape on Jun. 2 (FRC); **Atlantic Puffin** - 1 flew in from east and landed in rip at East Point still in summer plumage Jul. 8 (EVL); **Mourning Dove** - abundant this spring in many areas; **Eastern Screech Owl** - heard at Bethel on Apr. 11 (TR); **Great Horned Owl** - heard at Bethel on Apr. 11 (TR), 1 heard at Indian Bridge on May 8 and 1 on Jun. 5 at Morell (DO); **Barred Owl** - heard at Bethel on Apr. 11 (TR); **Short-eared Owl** - 1 at Bear River on Jul. 14 (EVL); **Northern Saw-whet Owl** - heard at Bethel on Apr. 11 (TR), 1 heard at Indian Bridge on May 6 (DO), 1 calling nightly for most of Jun. in Donagh (JDM, RPh), at least 2 males & 3 females at Argyle Shore feeders (LY, DH); **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** - first one seen in Hazelgrove this year on May 14th (KM), first one at French Village on May 14 (HG), one at Crossroads on May 16 (DO), 2 males at Morell River on May 15 (WK), male at Stanhope on May 15 (F&JC); 1 at East Royalty on May 19 (EMa), lots at feeders in French Village in early Jul. (HG); **Belted Kingfisher** - 1 at Hardy's Pond on Apr. 10 (MJ), 4 in Brackley Beach on May 6 (SC); **Yellow-bellied Sapsucker** - 1 male at Rocky Point feeder on Apr. 20 (LD), 1 at East Royalty on Apr. 24 (EMa),
