WINNIPEG, Dec. 16 — (CP) — Prices firmed up near the close today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange after showing an irregular and easier tone earlier in the active session.

Outside liquidation, mostly in barley, was well absorbed by shipping and continental interests. Oats trade was light throughout. Flax received further resting orders for exporters and industrial interests. Americans picked up rye.

Trade reports indicated a cargo of Canadian barley had been sold to Germany and also a small parcel had been sold to Belgium.

There was no information available on export loadings of Canadian wheat.

Prices for the top grades of class two drums were up 3 1/2 cents from yesterday.
