Both dealer vulnerable.

South deals.

♠ 8 AK 10 9 5
♥ 7 4 2
♦ 6 5 2
♣ 3

♠ K Q 10 9
♥ 6

The bidding:

South West North East
1♣ Pass 2♥ Pass
2♦ Pass 3♥ Pass

Opening lead—three of spades.

North's two heart response is an immediate slam try. It is a universally accepted principle in modern bidding that any new suit named by the responding hand constitutes a one round force. It is not necessary for the responder to make a jump bid to assure a rebid by the opener.

Once this basic principle is appreciated, it certainly seems logical to extend to a jump shift response the interpretation that a slam is being sought. Put into points, the responder who makes a jump shift response guarantees 17 points minimum. Some of the points may be distributional, but nearly all of them are high card points. In the present case North has 16 high card points, but the
