

Challenge To Debate Accepted

OTTAWA (CP)—Harold Winch has accepted the challenge of Nigeria's permanent United Nations delegate to debate on radio or television of the Vancouver MP's statements that Africans are aiming at world domination.

The New Democratic member of the Commons for Vancouver East said in an interview he would be pleased to discuss at any time with Chief S. O. Adede the impressions he received during a five-week visit to Nigeria. "I would only ask that prior to such a meeting, if it can be arranged, that the Nigerian ambassador have available the reports of the Cukor tribunal investigation into graft and corruption and the speeches made by the Afro-Asian delegates to the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association conference in Nigeria and in particular those made by Nigerian Establishments Minister Shakara."

Chief Adede issued the debate challenge in an interview with UN. He said he wants to discuss how Mr. Winch gained "erroneous" impressions of the aims and objectives of African peoples in their search for greater co-operation and unity. Mr. Winch made his controversial statements about Africa and Nigeria in an interview last Wednesday on his return from a five-week intensive in Nigeria.

Less Meat, More Greens Recommended

QUEBEC (CP)—The Canadian Heart Foundation recommended less meat and more greens for people with a high level of cholesterol in the blood or with a family history of coronary heart disease. The foundation said in a statement released in several countries have linked high levels of cholesterol—a fatty substance in the blood—with heart disease. Saturated fats, or those of animal origin, were particularly likely to increase the cholesterol level. Unsaturated fat, of vegetable origin, "shows a slight tendency to decrease the level of blood cholesterol."

The foundation chose industrialist Donald A. White, Ambridge, 64, as president to succeed Rt. Hon. Louis St. Laurent. Mr. Ambridge retains the job as president and general manager of Albit's Power and Paper Company limited and plans to keep a close personal eye on what heart researchers are doing with the grants they get from the foundation.

Dr. Paul David of Montreal, a new vice-president, told reporters heart researchers haven't gone far enough yet to be able to link smoking and arterial troubles definitely. "We don't feel in a position to advise people to quit smoking at this time."

Insect Poses Big Problem In St. John's

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—The earwig, a yellowish insect, has become so common in some parts of this old city that living in the areas "is becoming intolerable," a resident complained to city council.

W. R. Dave said in a letter to council that he has obtained only "slight relief" from the insects by keeping a light burning in both front and rear entrances of his home.

The earwigs first appeared in the city about 20 years ago, and the blame has been fixed on British Columbia wood used in home construction by the St. John's Housing Corporation. They have rapidly spread through the central portions of the city.

The council instructed city officials to seek help from the provincial government in finding a way to rid the city of earwigs. City engineer, Duncan Sharpe said B.C. officials are having similar problems with the insect.

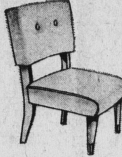
Plans Unchanged For Icebreakers, Balcer Reports

OTTAWA (CP)—Transport Minister Balcer said here the government will carry out the same icebreaking routine on the St. Lawrence River this year as it did last year. Douglas Fisher (NDP—Port Arthur) asked if the government had not received complaints from Maritime communities that the ice was very thin and was subsidizing their own ice-making. St. Lawrence River ports officials said they had no changes being contemplated in this year's icebreaking routine. The aides issued recently were identical with those issued a year ago, he added.
