

### Arrange Program For Visit Of Eisenhower To Ottawa

OTTAWA (CP) — Prime Minister Diefenbaker Thursday announced details of the "friendly and quite informal" program arranged for the four-day visit of President Eisenhower to Ottawa starting July 8.

Highlights of the July 8-11 visit as far as the general public is concerned will be the president's address to a joint sitting of the Canadian Commons and Senate and his placing of a wreath at the National War Memorial, both in the morning of July 9.

There will be at least two conferences involving the president, the prime minister, Secretary of State Dulles and External Affairs Minister Smith.

The visiting party will consist of President and Mrs. Eisenhower, Mr. and Mrs. Dulles and members of the president's personal staff.

The president's last Ottawa visit was in November, 1953. Mr. Diefenbaker visited Washington briefly last October, accompanying the Queen and Prince Philip there.

### Big Beechwood Hydro Project Opened Saturday

BEECHWOOD, N.B. (CP) — The largest hydro development in New Brunswick's history, completed more than two months ahead of schedule, was officially opened here Saturday.

The \$27,000,000 plant at this spot on the St. John River 100 miles northwest of Fredericton cost about \$2,000,000 less than the original estimate.

Approximately 1,000 spectators saw Premier Hugh John Flemming cut a ribbon and declare the project open. It was three years and 17 days after he formally initiated the construction.

Sunshine and cloud alternated during the opening ceremony. Rain sprinkled as three Neptune anti-submarine aircraft from Greenwood, N.S., and four Sabre jets from Chatham, N.B., swept over the site. The Black Watch military band of Halifax played before and after the ceremony.

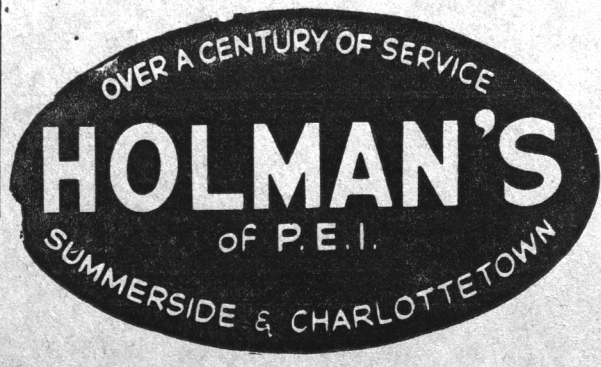
