**Que. Fisheries Official Urges Gulf As Territorial Waters**

QUEBEC (CP) — A Quebec way to put federal money to government fisheries official maximum benefit, but he won't advise whether this had been a wise decision.

The suggestion comes from Deputies Minister J. B. Bergevin of the fisheries branch of Quebec's department of industry and commerce.

Writing in *Actualites Marines* (Marine News), a provincial government fisheries review, Mr. Bergevin also suggests a full analysis of fish prices at all stages of production and marketing.

Ways of increasing the return to fishermen for their catch should also be searched for, as well as new markets for her fish.

Mr. Bergevin says there should be closer cooperation between the federal and provincial governments regarding use of public money to build fishing boats or port installations.

**INVESTIGATION WANTED**

He says the federal government should look for new foreign markets, and include fisheries products in its program of assistance to under developed countries.

Government and industry should cooperate more in transport of marine products, their marketing and wholesale and retail handling.

All such activities, the deputy minister said, should be carried out "in the context of the economy of the Atlantic provinces—Quebec included—with close federal co-operation."

Though the fisheries account for only 0.1 per cent of Quebec total production, they had a regional importance that could not be ignored.

Some 6,000 persons of the 200,000 living in fishing regions made their living in the fisheries industry.

**31 PER CENT EMPLOYED**

About 11 per cent of the labor force in the Gaspé, on the north shore and the Magdalen Islands were employed in this industry.

Mr. Bergevin noted while production hasn't increased in Quebec in a decade, productivity has. The number of fishermen dropped to 3,700 in 1961 from 7,500 in 1945.

Despite fishermen hadn't existed before 1951, but there were now 700 working with boats more than 35 feet long.

He noted in 1963, the Quebec government set up a program to build steel fishing boats as a

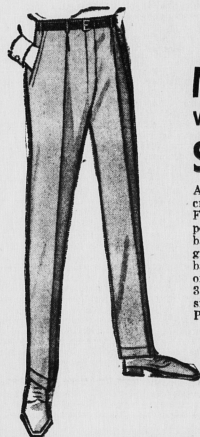
