NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market moved unevenly higher Thursday as it broke a four-day losing streak. Trading was light.
Volume of 1.000,000 shares from 5,600,000 Wednesday.

The moderate advance was accelerated by brokers chiefly to technical reasons.
The overall list was lower at the start Thursday except for certain issues, among them the "growth" stocks which were advanced sharply. The list gradually firmed and then moved up.

The lightness of volume, however, showed that the action was precautionary. There was moderate buying in the afternoon to generate a vigorous rally.

Most early gains were in the "growth" stocks favored by investors. The market as a whole held only about half of its best advance.

The Associated Press advance of 40 stocks gained \$1 at 214.60. Among them were stocks traded on the New York Stock Exchange. Distillers Seagrams advanced 1/4 and Dome Mining 1/2.

Declining were Aluminum Ltd. and McIntyre Petroleum 1/4; Canadian Pacific and Gooderham 1/4.

American Stock Exchange price advanced 1/2 to 200.30. Volume was 76,000 compared with \$30,000 Wednesday. Shawinigan, Prairie and Imperial Corp. advanced 1/4; Seury Rainbow Oil 1/4.
