WINNIPEG, Oct. 3 - (CP)- Prices were generally easier in today's trading on Winnipeg Grain Exchange, though rye prices recovered toward the close.

Commercial demand was indifferent in oats and barley, being limited to a few shipping orders. Hedging sales increased.

Rye was soft in the early trade, on selling by United States interests, but firmed later.

Dealings generally were dull. Class two wheat prices fell three cents.

Substantial export loadings were reported overnight, totalling close to 5,000,000 bushels. Biggest purchasers were the United Kingdom, about 2,000,000 bushels; Belgium, 1,900,000 bushels; and Chile about 360,000 bushels.
