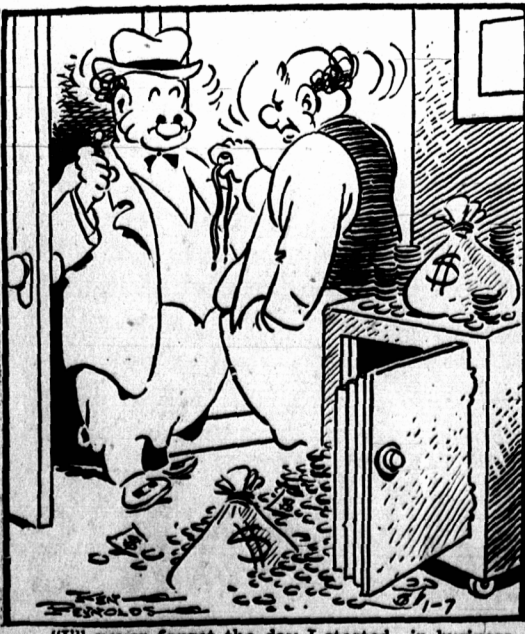

WINNIPEG, Feb. 5 - (CP) - All prices showed a firmer trend at the close today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, following early sharp losses. Demand was aggressive in the late stages, particularly in flax which fell the maximum 15-cent limit in initial trades. However, support brought the nearby above yesterday's close and reduced losses in other contracts. Other commodities also rallied under good buying. Rye came back from losses of as much as 6c cents to post gains. A better tone in United States markets prompted advances here. Export loadings of Canadian wheat included 435,000 bushels to Belgium, 300,000 to Norway, 375,000 to United Kingdom, 700,000 to India, 365,000 to Malia, 375,000 to the Netherlands, 370,000 to France, 17,000 to South Africa and 60,000 to Sweden.
