ATTENTION POTATO GROWERS

The attention of all farmers is directed to the provisions of the Prince Edward Island Potato Production Act passed in 1947 whereby all persons planting one acre or more of potatoes must plant those of the "Certified" class or better.
Also be advised that any grower whose field or land has borne a crop of potatoes infected with any plant disease or pest shall not permit the same area to be planted to potatoes the following year except on the authority of an Inspector, and shall destroy any volunteer plants on such land.
Areas so infected in 1956 will be policed to see that these regulations are strictly enforced.

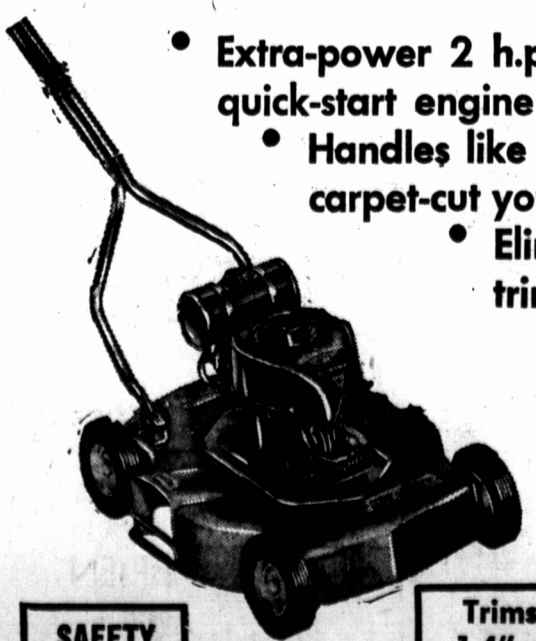
