See how the potato tops are being spud. Killed Now

Potato tops should be killed down immediately to help check the feared development of rot in tubers, it was stressed yesterday by L.C. Calbeck, research officer at the Experimental Farm, who keeps watch on late blight development through the season, along with P.M. Cannon.

DANGER INCREASE
If the tops are allowed to remain green much longer, the danger of late blight loss will increase. With few fine days available for top killing this fall—the spray has to remain on the tops long enough to take effect—and because the tops should be dead for several days before digging, it is recommended that the fields be treated at the earliest opportunity, he said.

Mr. Calbeck warned that the greatest care should be taken where arsenical mixtures are used for top killing, as the spray is highly poisonous and dangerous to livestock, many of which were killed by the mixture last year.

Avoid the possibility of any spray drifting into a pasture, and do not spill any of the poison along any stream or brook. He added that cattle must be strictly fenced and any feed containers should not be left around where they can be a source of rot.

Governor - General Vanier opened the first session of the 26th Parliament, reading the speech from the throne in the Senate.

Marcel Lambert (PC - Edmonton West) was elected Speaker of the Commons with all parties supporting his nomination. In the Commons, Gordon Chouhan (PC - Winnipeg South) was named Deputy Speaker, also a member of the present cabinet for the company.

All party spokesmen supported Mr. Diefenbaker's suggestion that the Commons might consider naming a permanent Speaker.

"The optimism has a hollow ring because it sounds exactly like the optimism we heard right through the election campaign and until three days ago."
