Rusk Urges Cuban Sanctions By Latin American Countries
WASHINGTON (AP) - U.S. State Secretary Dean Rusk urged the Latin American republics Wednesday to slap sanctions on Cuba in protest against Fidel Castro regime government of the Americas "who no longer have the right to port violation."

Gun Battle Is Reported
NICOSIA (AP) - A gun battle broke out Wednesday near the village of a refugee settlement of Hamid Marad but resulted to a halt without casualties.
United Nations observers said 40 to 50 shots were exchanged during the battle, but Greek Cypriots during the 45-minute fight.

Operation Seen On Lung Cancer
COPENHAGEN (Reuters) - Danish television viewers Wednesday night were given a four-minute glimpse of a surgical operation during which a soft lump of a 30 - cigarette - a day smoker was removed from the patient's body.
The doctor explained a gland tumor of the lung, which he said was also pointed out dark spots on the lung surface where the tumor was growing through the tissues from inside.

TORONTO (CP) - The annual production slowdown while tooling up for new models has been operating on drastically reduced production schedules.
American Motors Co. (Canada) Ltd. announced Monday that it had lowered production of its cars and trucks for the year ending July 31.
Others have almost halted production of cars and trucks scheduled for production for the week ending July 25 compared with 1962 units actually produced the week ended July 19.
