MONTREAL, June 11 (CP)—Pound sterling strengthened 3-32 to 4.68 31-32 on Montreal foreign exchanges Saturday while the United States dollar remained unchanged at 1.00 1-8. French francs were narrowly higher at 2.65 3-8.

NEW YORK, June 11 (CP)—The Netherlands guilder came out of a morning decline of as much as .06 of a cent to close .02 of a cent lower at 53.24 cents in terms of United States funds on the foreign exchange market Saturday.

The Pound Sterling was unchanged at \$4.68 5-16 while the French franc dipped 1-16 of a point to 2.65 cents.

The federal reserve bank reported engagements of \$4,612,000 gold in the United Kingdom and \$1,888,000 in Holland for shipment here.

TORONTO, June 11 (CP)—Stocks maintained an upward slant in the final session of the week, closing with gains in the industrial and gold groups and a moderate decline in the base metal list.

Western oils finished the day with minor losses. Some of the secondary goods sold off in the last 10 minutes but independent of these losses the index for the goods was up .56 for the day. Volume at 210,000 shares was heavier than on the previous Saturday.

The trade was featured by the advance of Annor to a new high at 2.05 for a gain of 8 cents. It traded 27,000 shares and gained 3 1-2 cents to 38 1-2 while other juniors did better included Central Porcupine and Wood Cadillac O'Brien advanced 20 cents to 2.60 on comparatively light trade and the close was narrowly higher for Central Patricia, Coniarum, Lamaque, Kirkland Lake, Teck Hughes and Wright-Hargreaves.

Lake Shore advanced a point.

Senior base metal shares showed practically no change but the cheaper issues weakened moderately. Waite-Amulet declined 20 cents to 7.10 and Pend Oreille and Sherritt weakened slightly. Eldorado sold down 5 cents to 1.30 and Mining Corporation lost 5 cents to 1.10. Imperial Oil and International Petroleum added small fractions and gains of a half point or more came out for Abitibi pfd, Bell Telephone, Burlington Steel, Canada Steamships pfd, Canadian Car pfd, the Gatiniau issues and Massey pfd.

Western oils boarded few changes. Devises added a fraction while Home, Okalta and Anglo-Canadian were off 1 to 3 cents.
