Anne Lapp 13, Scores Two Of Highest Marks

SUMMERSIDE — A total of 20 classes were held in the second day of the Summerside section of the P.E.I. Music Festival here yesterday. There were no evening sessions. Anne Lapp, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Keith Lapp captured the highest marks of the day with a high of 88 in a piano solo for girls 13 years of age. The pert youngster also registered an 87 in a piano solo 'sonatina' for entries 13 and 14 years of age.

Also awarded 87 for an individual effort was June Phillips of Summerside in the piano solo — 'sonatina' — for entries 12 years and under. The Kirkora School's Girls' Chorus was awarded a high mark of 86 by adjudicator Christopher Le Fleming in a two-part performance for girls 16 years and under.

Also adjudicating for the second day was Edgar "Billy" Boucher.

The festival resumes at nine o'clock this morning with the first class on the program at Civic Auditorium being a school chorus (one room) for grades 1 to 4. Adjudicator today will be Frances Cameron.
