(1) P.E.I. COUNCIL OF WOMEN BURSARY

This bursary is open to full-time mature female students.

This bursary is valued at \$100.00 and is based on need.

DEADLINE: September 27, 1985

(2) P.E.I. TEACHER'S FEDERATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to senior students (with high marks) who are dependents of teachers. The scholarship is valued at \$1,000.00.

DEADLINE: September 30, 1985

(3) FREIDA CREELMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
