The *Telegram* says: "A despatch was received in this city this morning from the leading sporting men at Auburn to the effect that the most intense feeling exists in that city against Courtney, as they believe he sold the race. A large number congregated at Cosgrove & Miller's place in Genesee Street, and it was proposed by some to drive Courtney out of the town when he should return home. Many have lost heavily on Courtney, mostly merchants, who helped to subscribe funds to aid him, in the hope of bringing the race to Owassa Lake."

LONDON, Oct. 4.

The rumor of the betrothal of Prince Louis Napoleon to Princess Thira of Denmark is revived.

The British brig *Anglo*, from St. John, N. B., for Queenstown, was sighted on 5th of September with her foremast and jib-boom gone, and ten feet of water in her hold. She refused assistance.

LONDON, Oct. 4.

In reference to the statement published yesterday in the *Morning Advertiser*, that the Admiral of the East Indian squadron had been ordered to send a number of vessels into the Persian Gulf, a despatch from Constantinople says: "Layard, the British Ambassador to Constantinople, is informed that the pirates have made their appearance in the Persian Gulf and Gulf of Volo, and has asked permission from the Porte to send British men-of-war to operate against them."

LONDON, Oct. 4.

A despatch from Florence says the population is excited because a member of the International was killed in a duel by an officer of a Bersaglieri regiment. The troops are confined to barracks, and it is hoped agitation will subside without disturbance.

VIENNA, Oct. 4.

The following official telegram has been received: "Sarajevo, Oct. 4.—The Austrians entered Vesegroid this morning, unopposed. The insurgents evacuated their entrenchments, abandoning tents, cannon and all ammunition. The Austrians entered Gaszada yesterday unopposed, and to-day occupied it. The Cajuica district of Fagia is cleared of insurgents, and thus the whole of Bosnia and Herzegovina is subdued, and the country in our hands."

CONSTANTINOPLE, Oct. 4.

The Government have received intelligence that Saad Delden Pasha, on announcing that he had received orders to surrender Podgoritz to the Montenegrins, was killed by the Albians, and 156 officers and men under his command were massacred.
