Grain WINNIPEG, June 14 - (CP) - Selling expanded today on the latter half of the Winnipeg Grain Exchange session, with sharp losses recorded in all coarse grains except flax, where there was no trading. A large part of the offerings were on American accounts, with some local selling but a limited commercial demand. Some selling was prompted by a forecast of showers for the prairie grain belt, and favorable returns from American harvest operations.
