WOOL

The Producers' Co-operative Association Limited, Charlottetown, is now open for the handling of wool for the Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers Limited. It would be advisable to ship your wool as early as possible. Fleece twine, shipping tags, and wool sacks are available from the Producers' Co-operative, Charlottetown, and they may also be picked up at the following:

Tignish Co-op; O'Leary Co-op; Summerside Co-op; Arsenault & Gaudet; Wellington; Morell Co-op; and Souris Co-op.

Ship your wool collect to:

PRODUCERS' CO-OPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, LIMITED, CHARLOTTETOWN, P. E. I.

EACH SACK SHOULD BE TAGGED WITH THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE OWNER WRITTEN IN CLEAR LETTERING WITH INK, ONE TAG TO BE SECURELY ATTACHED TO THE OUTSIDE OF THE SACK AND ANOTHER PLACED ON THE INSIDE.

It is in your interest to see that wool is properly prepared for market. Growers should:

1. Remove all tags and dung locks before tying each fleece.
2. Any burry, chaffy, or strawy portions of wool should also be removed and shipped separately.
3. Sheep should be shorn when dry, and wool should be stored in a place free from dampness.
4. If there are any black fleeces pack them in separate bags.
