Wonders About Railway Closing

HALIFAX (CP)—The provincial government says it wants to know what effect the proposed abandonment of a C. M. B. rail line would have on the district's economy. The Halifax and Coal Company's Premier Stanfield said here today his government is keeping in touch with the Maritime transport commission to see if there is any action which should be taken.

The company, a subsidiary of Dominion Steel and Coal Corporation, has applied to the board of transport commissioners for permission to abandon the line. It would leave Parrboro's 2,000 residents without railway service.

The company indicated it would remove all its property including about 28 miles of track between Parrboro and Springhill.

H. C. M. Gordon, general manager of the Cumberland Railway and Coal Company, told Parrboro Mayor George P. Graham he line has been losing money for several years.

Mayor Graham said: "It's a blow to this part of the country and especially to the town. We are protesting it, of course."

Bugs Invade Toronto Area

TORONTO (CP)—Swarms of tiny brown bugs invaded a section of downtown Toronto Monday. No one knows why, or from where they came.

The quarter-inch long bugs are squash beetles which were found on trees and found their way into fifth-floor offices. Along Bay Street office workers and shoppers walked with their heads down as though in a snow flurry.

Royal Ontario Museum entomologists said they were harmless. Dr. Fred Ureahart of the museum identified the insects as little bugs or frog-hoppers.

He said he could not explain their arrival but "there must be a lot in the suburbs."
