WINNIPEG, May 2 - (CP) - Weakness in United States market prices was displayed in oats and barley futures in trading on Winnipeg Grain Exchange today, with both grains reacting with sharp losses. Commercial demand was limited and there was an increase in selling. Rye started off slowly but recovered as the session proceeded. Trading was nervous and moderately active. In export business, the United Kingdom was allocated 130,000 bushels of wheat under the Anglo-Canadian wheat agreement and Belgium was the purchaser of 380,000 bushels.
