



PRESENTATION MADE TO RETIRED OFFICER

R.C. Parent, superintendent of the Dominion Experimental Farm in Charlottetown, presented a document to B.F. Tinney of Charlottetown yesterday at a ceremony at the farm. The document was presented on behalf of the federal minister of agriculture Douglas Harkness to Mr. Tinney who retired some months ago after 42 years of service at the farm. Prior to his retirement Mr. Tinney was the research officer in charge of poultry.

**Speed Charge Brings \$15 Fine**

A Wood Islands truck driver was convicted on a charge of speeding in Magistrate's Court before Magistrate Gilbert A. Gaudet Monday morning.

The accused was fined \$15 and costs or 30 days.

The charge was filed by a Winsloe man who followed the truck from Winsloe to a garage on Malpeque Road. The charge read that the accused had reached speeds of up to 70 m.p.h. on the Malpeque Road.

The accused and a passenger in the truck testified that while the truck may have reached 50 m.p.h. a governor would have prevented it from exceeding 65 m.p.h.

Residents of Halifax and Charlottetown also appearing on speeding charges were fined \$10 and costs or 10 days. Both pleaded guilty as charged.

A charge of assault against a North Rustico man was dismissed. Magistrate Gaudet said that in view of conflicting evidence he had no choice but to dismiss the charge.

**M.C.A. Buys New Airliner**

Maritime Central Airways recently took delivery of a new \$1,300,000 airliner for use in international service and long-haul northern operations.

The new Douglas DC-6A, which can cruise at 330 m.p.h., carries 90 passengers. It is fitted for conversion as a freight carrier.

The big aircraft was flown non-stop from Vancouver to Moncton by MCA's chief pilot G.J. Godfrey of Moncton and check pilot C.E. Blair of Montreal. Other crew members were First Officer J.S. Steeves and Flight Engineer R.J. Richard both of Moncton.
