—GERMAN FARM WORKERS - Final discussion of the day had to do with bringing more German farm workers to the Island under the Assisted Passage Scheme.

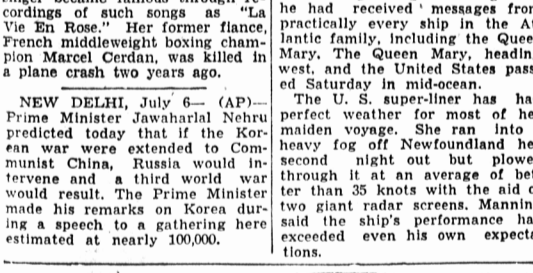
