

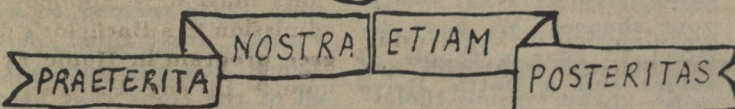
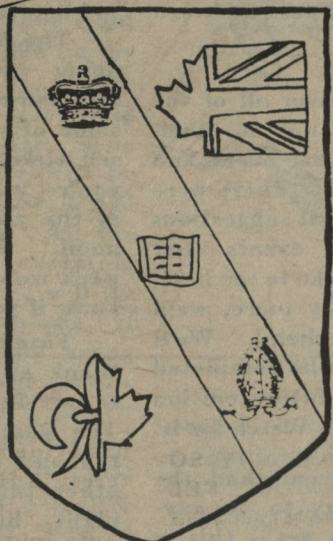
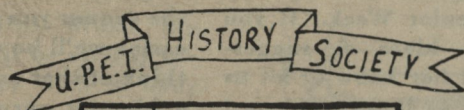
HISTORY SOCIETY

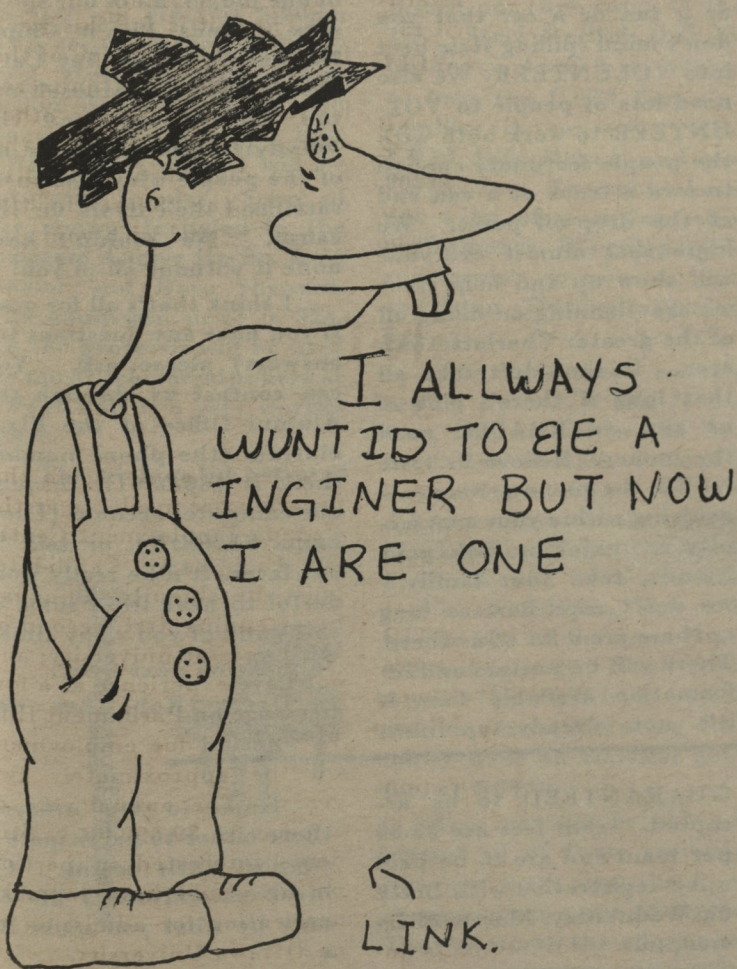
