BBC Would Like Monroe For Greek Comedy

LONDON (Reuters)—The BBC sees Marilyn Monroe as just the girl to play the lead in Lysistrata, highbrow Greek comedy about a lady who organizes a sex strike among wives and thus ends a war.

But Marilyn said Friday movie commitments make it impossible to consider the BBC offer at the moment.

The BBC was planning to produce the play, written by Aristophanes in 412 B.C., as an anniversary treat for listeners to the Third Program, which for the last 10 years has been catering to the tastes of British intellectuals.

The producer of the Third Program has been long to broadcast the new translation of the comedy—by American Professor Dudley Fitts—but the right Lysistrata just never came along until the Hollywood glamor girl turned up in England.

NOBODY BUT MARILYN
"If Miss Monroe has declined to play the part—she hasn't answered our letter yet—we shall have to give up the idea of producing the play," a BBC spokesman said sadly.

"I am familiar with Lysistrata and I think it has a wonderful title role," Marilyn said. "I would certainly like to play it some day but my commitments in The Sleeping Prince (a movie with Sir Laurence Olivier) make it impossible to consider it at the moment."

The BBC, which said its "listeners would be very much charmed" if Marilyn would play the part, was even willing to renege the production if the blonde actress' working schedule demanded.

Prof. Fitts in his translation represents the two opposing sides in the play's war—the Spartans and the Athenians—as American armies of the north and south. The Spartans would speak with the accent of the deep south. Miss Monroe, as an Athenian, would talk like a Yankee.

The name Lysistrata means dissolver of armies. According to Aristophanes, this "Liz" was both beautiful and intelligent. She dissolved armies by persuading Greek wives to go on a sex strike until their husbands gave up the idea of fighting a silly war.

Pacified Area Far From Peaceful

ALGIERS (AP)—Three Algerian rebel ambushes within 25 miles of this capital city have resulted in deaths of 27 French soldiers and at least as many wounded or missing. French authorities said Friday.

At the same time, the French estimated that "several dozens" of Moslem villagers near Constantine were massacred Thursday in what were termed "rebel terror raids" in so-called pacified areas.
