- meant to be listened to successively. Here's the song-by-song rundown:
1. Deuce-- Lenny Kravitz... A funkier version, but it doesn't quite work. Great harmonica from Stevie Wonder.
  2. Hard Luck Woman-- Garth Brooks... It's not Country. 'Nuff said.
  3. She-- Anthrax... Better than the Anthrax norm. This track rocks hard.
  4. Christine-- Sixteen Gin Blossoms... Decent, but nothing to get excited over. It's a little too light.
  5. Rock and Roll All Nite-- Toad The Wet Sprocket... A great track. A beautifully executed acoustic version.
  6. Calling Dr. Love-- Shandi's Addiction... Disjointed and confusing. Shouldn't have made the final cut.
  7. Goin' Blind-- Dinosaur Jr... Layered guitars and strings make this track work. It's one of the best on this disc.
  8. Strutter-- Extreme... Listenable, with some great guitar work, but nothing special.
  9. Plaster Caster-- The Lemonheads... Great heavy rock. Well played.
  10. Detroit Rock City --The Mighty Mighty Bosstones... Metal guitar with

a horn section, a gospel choir, and a strangling jazz vocalist. Somehow, this works... well.

11. Black Diamond-- Yoshiki... The most surprising track on this compilation, and also the best. This is a full-blown orchestral version. It alone is well worth the price of admission.

For a Kiss fan, or for all fans of modern music, this disc is a very good investment. Stone Temple Pilots, Ozzy Osbourne, Alice in Chains, Run DMC, and many other noteworthy bands also recorded for this project, but didn't make the cut. Look for a KISS MY ASS TWO in the near future.

**Sandra Bernhard**  
**Excuses For Bad Behaviour-- Part one (Sony)**  
Yes, this is the same woman you have seen chumming around with Madonna and starring in the hit sitcom Roseanne

When I began listening to this album the first thing that popped into

my mind was "is this a joke?". The first song ("You make me feel") sounds like a teenager attempting a raunchy pop song. My guess is she's making fun of pop music.

The next selection on this 17-track CD is a song about manic depression-- fittingly sung in a 60's-meets-grunge style. She starts in a really light, upbeat, 60's-soft-sweet voice (you almost feel high while listening to it), then switches to a wildly raunchy grunge style. She shifts from one style to the other throughout the whole song. To me the grunge music represented the 'manic' and the other style the 'depression'.

I won't review all the tracks, but suffice it to say that most are pretty terrible. I really think a lot of these songs would be great if performed before a live audience. The songs need her personality and presence to convey the meaning to the listener.

I didn't know how to take some of the songs on the CD. Either she is a really bad singer or she wants to

make a mockery of the music industry. She tries to be deep in some songs, but the way she sings them you never know if she is sincere or not.

She has two very good numbers, both of them cover songs: "Sympathy for the Dead" (a well-known Rolling Stones song), and "50 Ways to Leave Your Lover" (by Paul Simon). She adds a new twist to the latter by changing the lyrics and singing it from the perspective of a lesbian (hang up the phone, Joan/ Take that pill, Jill, Time to release, Denise, etc...). She also adds a funky beat to it, making it a really great song. Bernhard even shows a shred of singing talent in "Sympathy for the Dead," performing a slowed-down version of it quite capably.

I still think I missed the point of this CD. Bernhard titled it "Excuses For Bad Behaviour", but she doesn't really push the limits herein. If you want something new and funky, try this album out. If you really hate to hear bad singing, stick to the mainstream. This rates a 3, for originality.
