Gloria Swanson Scores In Hits On Stage, Film

NEW YORK, March 7 — (CP) — It was eight years ago that glamorous Gloria Swanson voiced the sentimental wish "I'd like to finish off my movie career in a nice way—with an exclamation point instead of a dreary period."

Eight years later, she is still a box office best seller on the stage as star of "Twentieth Century" at Broadway's Fulton Theatre and as film star in the hit movie, "Sunset Boulevard". On both radio and television she is one of the busiest and most successful performers. In the business world she is a successful manufacturer of new plastics, alloys and smart dress patterns for textile manufacture.

In the stage version of "Twentieth Century" which is attracting \$23,000 a week and more on Broadway where \$16,000 a week gross is adjudged to be a hit, she is playing the glamorous screen star which she is, in fact, in real life. Her role in "Sunset Boulevard", won her acting awards from nationwide critics' polls and such praise that she is one of the chief candidates for the film academy award.

Discussing the many new honors which have come to her at the age of 51, she seemed to take delight in quoting a headline from the Oklahoma City "Daily Oklahoman" which said: "Here's Gloria Swanson. At 51, she's still the bee's knees."

Miss Swanson doesn't take her age too seriously, despite the fact she doesn't like to be reminded she has had such a long career. It started when she was 14 years old and her aunt took her to Essanay Studios in Chicago. The next stop for young Miss Swanson was Hollywood, starring in Mack Sennett bathing beauty comedies. "When anyone speaks of age," she said, "I often wonder what would have happened to Romeo and Juliet if they had lived many, many more years than they did."

Favors Comedy

"Although 'Sunset Boulevard' gives me a serious and tragic role, what I get most fun out of are the roles which make people laugh.

"I've often wondered what would have happened if I had pursued my original serious intention to be a singer. My first talking picture was 'The Tresspasser' and I sang a song called 'Love, Your Magic Spell Is Everywhere.' I don't know how good a singer I was, but Elsie Janis coached me on how to sing this song.

"What Elsie Janis taught me and what I learned from Grace Moore helped me a lot, especially when I moved over to talking pictures and to speaking stage roles. I haven't done any singing in stage or movie roles since 1933, but those singing lessons made my speaking voice higher and now it has settled into a good, normal speaking voice."

If you happen on Broadway these days you can see and hear the ever youthful Gloria Swanson either on stage, screen or television. Failing these, you can find her in a half dozen or more other enterprises.
