CONTRACT BRIDGE

This particular effort was highly successful if South had simply elected to pass three nortrup after West had bid it. North would have cashed six heart tricks in a lumpy and scored 20 points for his side. But South was afraid that West might make a vulnerable game and chose to sacrifice at four spades. This was doubtless an unwise decision.

It does seem that South exercised poor judgment in going to four spades. If he played his partner for the normal 12 to 14 tricks, there should have passed on the basis that West would be unable to make nine tricks with at most 23 high card points. And if he played his partner for a psychic of whatever nature, it was obviously unwise to place his bid on the chopping block.

At the second table, the bidding was simpler but less movie effective. It went:

South West North East
Pass Pass 3 ♠ Pass Pass

Obviously, East would have completed against three hearts—presumably East with a double. The preemptive bid was extremely effective, even though North would set up two tricks short of his contract. Declarer made six trump tricks and a diamond ruff in dummy. East West, alert during the bidding, could have made six diamonds!

OTTAWA (CP)—The executive council of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce said Tuesday the cost of consumer goods should be disclosed to customers in dollars and cents rather than in the form of an annual interest rate as recommended by the royal commission on banking and finance.

In a letter to the Joint Common-Senate committee on consumer credit, the council opposed any legal requirement to disclose interest in contracts, saying this is "not practical in the case of all transactions."

The suggestion of Keith H. Macdonald, vice-president of the Industrial Association Corporation of Montreal, was a partial answer to the problem of interest disclosure as it excluded other forms of consumer credit such as layaway plans, seasonal payments, skip payments and bulk payments, where the calculation of interest rates required the consultation of trained experts.

"No mathematical formula is adequate to allow a retailer to permit the adding of a new purchase to an instalment account that already is running," the council said.

Mr. Martin said that the UN is in its most critical period. The countries now faced loss of their votes in the general assembly for failing to pay their peacekeeping assessments. By January 19, countries including France as well as Russia, would be in default.

Mr. Martin said if no solution is found to the problem of financing UN peacekeeping missions, the work of the UN will be undermined "and that is an understatement."

MAILMEN GET ANTI-DOG DEPT

COUNTRIES WHICH HAVE ACCEPTED ARE: Brazil, Denmark, Finland, Ghana, India, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Malaysia, the Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Sweden, Tunisia and the United Arab Republic.

Countries which so far have not accepted are: Ethiopia, Guyana, Indonesia, Liberia, Mali, Morocco, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Yugoslavia and Zaire.

Yugoslavia was the only Communist country invited—invited because it was the only Communist country confirmed to attend with UN peacekeeping expertise, except the major powers.

8 Europeans Are Killed By Congo Rebels

LEOPOLDVILLE (Reuters)—Eight Europeans, including two British fathers, have been killed recently by rebels in two widely-scattered areas of the Zaire province, it was learned here.

Six of the men were killed at the road and river junction of Bombe, northwestern Congo, before it was recaptured by government forces and white mercenaries Saturday.

The other two, Belgian missionary Fathers Lambert and Raymond of the Perseus Society, were killed during an unsuccessful rebel attack on the town of Katakombi Friday.

National Congolese army soldiers said they killed 67 rebels in Katakombi, and wounded the head of the rebel army, Gen. Nicholas Olinga.

The said Olinga was treated at the Roman Catholic Mission in the town and then taken by jeep to Kinshasa, about 120 miles to the northeast and the second most important city the rebels hold.

But reliable sources in Leopoldville refused to confirm the high-ranking rebel officer's reported in the clash was in fact Olinga, the man chiefly responsible for the rebel takeover in Stanleyville.
