## Used book sale

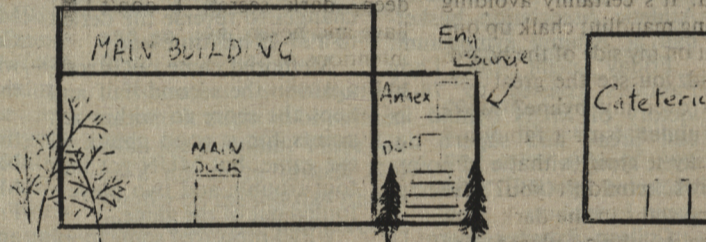
Attention all students:
