TREMBLEMENTS DE TERRE ET INONDATION DANS L'INDE

Plusieurs Européens perdent la vie.

Les environs de Darjeeling, dans le bas d'Himalaya, ont eu beaucoup à souffrir de tremblements de terre, de l'inondation et débordements terribles, récemment.

Les dommages sont considérables et plus de 60 personnes ont péri.

Il a plu 28 pouces d'eau en moins de 38 heures.

Un éboulement, qui est lieu entre Darjeeling et Sonada, a entraîné un convoi de chemin de fer rempli de voyageurs. D'après les derniers rapports, neuf Européens et 20 indigènes ont perdu la vie, entre ces deux endroits. Toute la route de Calcutta est obstruée et la voie de Paglajhora est sérieusement endommagée.

Une dépêche de Jalpaigney, sur la rivière Qeest, à 40 milles au sud-est de Darjeeling, dit qu'un bateau contenant trois Européens et six indigènes, sombra sur cette rivière, sous la violence des vagues. Le corps de l'une des victimes a été retrouvé à 14 milles en bas de la rivière.

On dit que les Européens, MM. Anderson, Knster et Whiten, ont sauté pardessus bord. On ne sait ce qu'il est advenu d'eux. Leurs compatriotes font des recherches actives pour retrouver leurs cadavres.

LE GENERAL OTIS FAIT EVACUER UN COLLEGE MEDICAL DE SAN JOSE

Le "Times", de Manille, dit que le général Otis a chassé les frères Dominicains du Collège Médical de San Jose, à Manille, et a mis cette institution sous la surveillance de la commission de l'éducation à Manille. Le général Otis avait donné quatre jours d'avis aux religieux qui ont refusé de se conformer aux ordres du général Otis. On dit que les Dominicains ont demandé aux étudiants de signer une pétition implorant la remise au collège, à ses anciens propriétaires supposés, mais les collègues ont refusé nettement. Ce collège médical était anciennement dirigé par le même comité que l'Université St Thomas. Il n'a jamais appartenu aux Dominicains, mais comme les Espagnols ne savaient par qui faire diriger cet établissement important, les frères de St Dominique se sont offerts et l'on a accepté leur demande.

Le "Times" dit que lors de la prise de Manille par les Yankees, les Frères ont eu possible de s'emparer du collège; ils ont agi comme s'ils eussent été les véritables maîtres, rédigeant les règlements de l'institution était purement médicale, les Américains ont cru qu'il était préférable de nommer des professeurs médecins, sans prendre en considération leur religion ou leurs croyances.

SUR LE CLERGE FRANCAIS

Il y a aujourd'hui, en France, 8,429 curés, et 28,573 desservants, 9,430 élèves de grands Séminaires, 2,198 élèves de petits Séminaires se destinant à entrer l'année prochaine au grand Séminaire. Dans les 87 diocèses de France et d'Algérie, on a ordonné cette année 1,657 prêtres, 1,549 sous-diacres.

Les diocèses les mieux pourvus de prêtres catholiques séculiers sont ceux de Besançon avec 59 curés, et 772 desservants; Arras, 47 curés, 662 desservants; Rodez, 51 curés, 615 desservants; Lyon, 73 curés, 594 desservants. Paris n'a que 39 curés, et 103 desservants, auxquels il convient d'ajouter 591 vicaires attachés aux paroisses. Il s'en fait donc que le nombre des curés soit proportionnel à l'importance et à la population des diocèses.

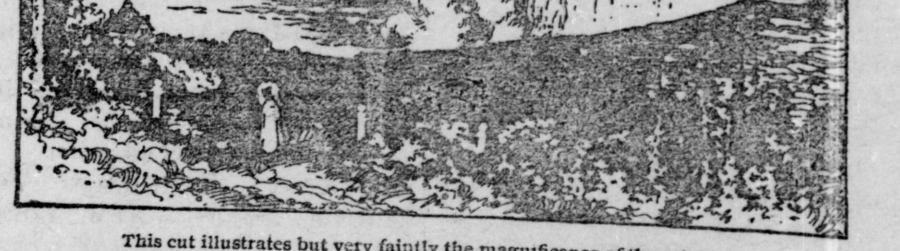
